

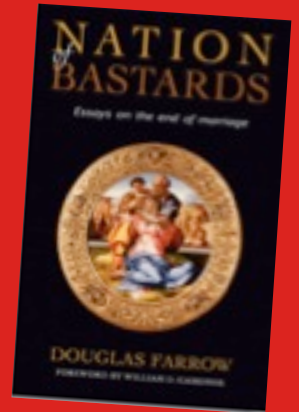
# Packaging Political Bondage as Personal Liberty:
