### What MercinTreno is?

"MercinTreno", the first international Summit on rail transport of goods, is an initiative of Federmobilità, association grouping the principal Italian departments for local transport.

It was dictated from the necessity to analyse the complex issue of freights rail transport mode, to increase the attention of Government, local authorities and national institutions about the prospect's growth and the sector's potentialities in Italy and Europe, while at the same time pay attention to the current liberalisation and the more recent regulations.

The Summit would provide a great opportunity to point out a very important problem for the development of a more and more sustainable mode of transport, also from the point of view of the quality of life.

The event has already achieved important recognitions, especially the support of Cnel (National Council of Economy and Labour), that will host the summit meeting at Villa Lubin in Rome.

The first day's program will be opened by an international meeting on the rail transport liberalisation with the attendance of important representatives of Italian and European policy and economy. Five seminars on the intermodality of networks, the infrastructure management, the co-modality development and the needs of rail transport of goods operators are also scheduled.

On the premises is also available a special space where institutions and companies could present their programs and products, their initiatives and solutions for the development of rail transport of goods.
