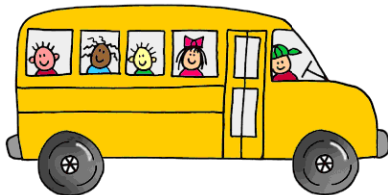
a shining light to the many different nations represented in our midst.

Hunger is my friend. "A worker's appetite works for him, for his hunger urges him on." (Pr. 16:26) I am *slowly* coming to realize how important hunger is. But I don't like it...yet. It keeps us alive; it keeps us going. If we were never hungry we'd forget to eat and waste away. We'd end up doing nothing. What a tragedy that would be! Jesus said, "Blessed are those who hunger for righteousness, for they will be filled." Spiritual hunger leads to searching, which leads to satisfaction. I pray the most when I most need help. I lean into God when life is most difficult. I am *starting* to be grateful for the trials that drive me to Jesus, for the hunger that is only satisfied in His presence. After all, what good is a Kingdom without the King? We can struggle and fret to do God's work in order to please Him, but too often we leave Him out of it. We hunger for the accomplishment of the task rather than the pleasure of His presence. We talk of being Kingdom-minded, but that should mean that we have the King on our mind. Pray with me this prayer: "Jesus I long for your presence."
