Dear Parents:

It is that time of year again to start thinking about Scout Summer Camp. Before you know it the school year will be ending and summer will be upon us. As you may know, Troop 174 is scheduled to attend Curtis S. Read Scout Reservation Camp in Brant Lake, NY, during the week of July 11 to 17, 2010. To find out more about the camp, you can visit their website. <http://www.wpcbsa.org>. Look under the Boy Scout Camps. We are staying at Camp Waubeeka. A copy of the Curtis Read Scout Camp Parents' Guide can be found on the Troop 174 Website (<http://bsatroop174.org>).

In order to attend summer camp, you must complete the enclosed Troop 174 Summer Camp Reservation form. This form serves as permission for your son to attend camp with the troop. The cost for a week of camp is \$330. Returning the permission form with a \$50.00 deposit will secure a place at camp for your son. The permission/reservation form must be returned with a \$50.00 deposit by May 12, 2010. The balance of \$280 will be due on May 26, 2010.

In addition to having a deposit for camp, you must complete the Class 3 Personal Health and Medical Record Form. A copy of this medical form can be found on the Troop 174 website (<http://bsatroop174.org>) in the Parents' Guide section. If you have more than one scout in the troop, each scout must have a form completed by their family physician. Many of you have filled out the Class 1 medical form. Curtis S. Read Camp requires the Class 3 Medical form to be filled out. This should give you time to make arrangements for your son to have his yearly physical, remember to have the Class 3 medical form filled out as well. The medical form is due June 9, 2010.

I hope this provides you with helpful information in planning for summer camp. In addition, there will be a parent summer camp informational session scheduled in the near future. You will receive further information about the date and time for the meeting.
