

Clothing donation guidelines:

- Clothing should be gently used or new
- Clothing is free from holes and stains
- Clothing is washed and clean
- Clothing is folded and separated into like groups
- Clothing is only accepted, other items (besides hygiene products) should be donated to the local Goodwill or Savers
- General rule: If you wouldn't wear it, neither will anybody else.
