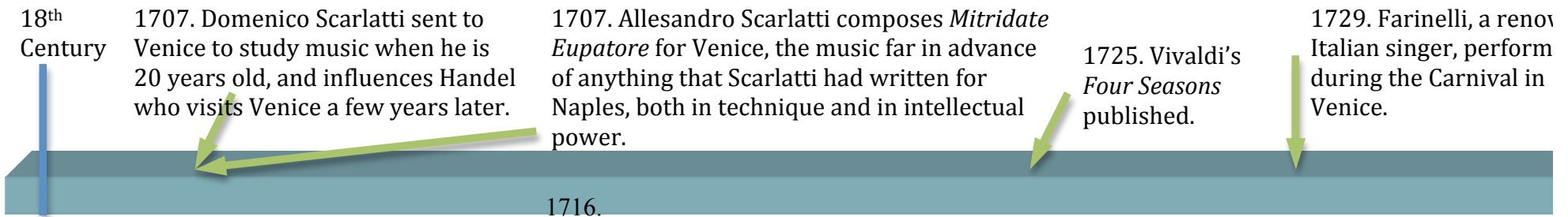


* Music history. top of line: Political history. bottom of line

1810. Italian composer

1830. Bellini's *I Capuleti ed i
Montecchi* performed in
Venice.

1883. German compose
Richard Wagner
"romantically" dies in
Venice.
