Dear Applicant,

Thank you for expressing interest in hosting a radio show for WHCS Hunter College Radio, "*Where Hunter College Speaks.*" We are excited to work together with you to create unique, original and informative programming for the Hunter College community. But before you submit your application, please keep the following details in mind.

We receive numerous applications every semester and can feasibly only accommodate so many shows in our current 40-hour a week broadcasting schedule (Monday-Friday, 11AM-7PM). The Program Director is ultimately responsible for the selection of applicants and priority is given to registered Hunter students. If selected, your time slot is limited to one hour per week. There will be mandatory system of delivering on-air station ID's, Live Reads, and commercials or public service announcements during your time slot.

Here are some additional requirements should you be selected as a DJ for WHCS:

- Serve at least one hour a week doing volunteer work for the station
- Arrive at least 15 minutes before your show is scheduled to begin
- Notify the Program Director or Office Manager in advance of any guests you wish to bring into the on air room and take full responsibility for their actions
- Food or drinks are prohibited in the On-Air and Studio rooms;
- Notify the Office Manager of any technical issues with the equipment.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in the withdrawal of your time slot. Appeals can be made to the General Manager for review.

If you have any further questions, please stop by our office, located in Room 101 on the first floor of the Thomas Hunter Building.
