Growing Faith at Home

The Faith Box, a uniquely Kiwi family faith sharing resource is being launched this week across New Zealand.

Developed by our own **Rev Nikki Watkin** (Kohimarama Presbyterian) and **Mary Grant**, the Faith Box encourages parents to proactively pass on faith to their children and equips them with the tools to make family devotions a weekly highlight.

Each week's session is jam-packed with family games, interactive activities, readings and sharing. The programme is developed for 5 to 10 years although younger and older siblings also love it.

There has been positive feedback from the families who piloted Faith Box.

"Since we started our weekly Faith Box nights, we have noticed a much better feeling of family togetherness" said one. "We are finding out what our children think about God, themselves and life," said another.

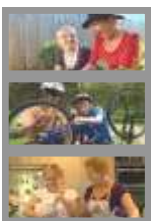
