**Argument A** The Argument from Unscientificity

**A1:** Our best fundamental scientific theories do not mention God.

**A2:** If our best fundamental scientific theories do not mention God, then there is no God.

**A3:** Therefore, there is no God.

**Science is the Measure of All Things:** If our best fundamental scientific theories don't mention  $X$ , then there are no  $X$ s.

**Argument B** The Argument from Evil, simple version

**B1:** If there is a God, then there is no evil.

**B2:** There is evil.

**B3:** Therefore, there is no God.

**Argument C** An Argument for B1

**C1:** If there is a God, then...

**C3:** Therefore, if there is a God, then there is no evil.
