

# Foundations III

## *Student Questions for the Correspondence Option*

### INTRODUCTION

This option to take the Foundations courses by correspondence is made available for the benefit of students who are not able to take the courses with a group for one of the following reasons:

- ❖ The courses are not being offered near the student's home.
- ❖ The student's work or family commitments do not allow him to complete the course with a group.
- ❖ The student has been a Christian for some time, already having a good grasp of the material, and is highly motivated to complete the courses in a shorter time period than group classes would allow.

It is usually most beneficial to the student to take the course with a group when possible. There is much to be gained through the weekly tests and corresponding feedback and other interaction with the teacher, tutor, and other students which is lost when taking the course by correspondence. In an attempt to compensate for the deficiency due to the lack of interaction, this correspondence version of the course contains questions that group students are not required to answer in writing. This is to help insure that the student is grasping the material.

Having taken Foundations III by correspondence, students are allowed to take Foundations IV either by correspondence or with a group.

One of the goals of the course is to have the student read the entire New Testament. Therefore, you will find a reading assignment with each lesson.

Answer the following questions in the enclosed assignment booklet. You will probably need to write on both sides of the paper in order to have sufficient space to complete all the assignments.

(Alternatively, if you are typing your answers, you may use plain white paper. In which case, be sure that each page is clearly identified on the top with your name, date, lesson number, and page number.)

7. Describe a time when God blessed you for your giving.

1. Read the entire book of 1 Corinthians and write a statement saying that you have done so.
2. Memorize and then write from memory Hebrews 12:14.
3. What does it mean to be holy?
4. List 5 ways by which holiness is developed in our lives.
5. Do you believe that God expects us to live without sinning against Him? Give at least 4 Scripture verses in support of your answer.
6. Why would a person choose to believe that it is impossible to live without sinning?
7. Share a time when the Holy Spirit convicted you of an area of sin in your life, and you never committed that sin again.
8. Is there any area of this lesson that you did not understand or where you disagree with the conclusions of the author? If so, please explain what it is you do not understand or why you disagree.

1. Read the entire book of 2 Corinthians and write a statement saying that you have done so.
2. Memorize and then write from memory Matthew 6:6.

3. List and explain 3 different moods of the Holy Spirit in prayer. Give an example of each.
4. What is a normal, total, and partial fast?
5. Ask God to show you how He would like you to fast. After you do so, write about your experience. What was the result?

1. Read the entire books of Galatians and Ephesians and write a statement saying that you have done so.
