Liability Waiver:

I fully understand and acknowledge that paintball is an inherently dangerous activity and that **(a)** risks exist in my use of paintball equipment and my participation in paintball activities; **(b)** my participation in paintball may result in serious bodily injury or death; **(c)** there are inherent hazards and/or risks associated with possible equipment failure and/or malfunction of the Rental Equipment, my own equipment or others' equipment; **(d)** paintball takes place outdoors, and therefore includes risks associated with exposure to the elements, such as excessive heat and excessive cold, and exposure to animals with the attendant risks of kicking, biting, stinging and other attacks, all of which may cause serious injury or death; **(e)** I will be exposed to risks associated with my own negligence and/or the negligence or willful misconduct of others including, but not limited to, equipment operator error and guide decision-making error, including, but not limited to, misjudging terrain, weather, trails, route location and other factors; **(f)** any and all of these risks may occur due to the negligence or intentional act or omission of the owners of the Premises, volunteers or agents of Community Bible Church, other participants, other persons, forces of nature and other causes, all of which may result from foreseeable or unforeseeable forces; and **(h)** by my participation in these activities, use of the Rental Equipment and by my signature below, I assume all risks and all responsibility for any injury, losses and/or damages, whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence or other conduct of the owners of the Premises, volunteers, or agents of Community Bible Church, or by any other person.

I agree to release, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the owner of **The Premises**, Community Bible Church, its officers, employees, volunteers and agents from and against any and all liability and costs arising in connection with the subject matter of this Paintball Agreement and Liability Waiver and that arise in connection with any act or omission of Participant or other person under Participant's direct control, including, but not limited to, liability resulting from any of the events described in the previous paragraph.

Safety Rules

All the rules of paintball are designed to keep you safe. Failure to follow any of the rules listed below will result in immediate removal from the game, shall constitute a breach of this Paintball Agreement and Liability Waiver and may result in your being denied participation in future Community Bible Church paintball events.

Wear your mask at all times

Wear your mask at all times. Do not remove your mask until you've reached a designated safe zone. Safe zones will be identified at the beginning of each game. There are no exceptions to this rule. If this rule is violated you will not be allowed to play for the remainder of the day's event.

Listen to the referees

The referees are in charge. If they make a call that you don't agree with, please talk to them about it **after the game**. They are there for your safety and protection.

No blind firing

Do not fire if you can't see what you are firing at. Many players are tempted to stick their guns out and fire without looking, avoid this. Blind firing can lead to accidentally shooting players who are leaving the field, referees or other things you shouldn't shoot, like your own teammates.

Surrenders

Close-range shots are considerably more painful than shots from a distance and **you are required** to offer an opportunity to "surrender" to any opposing player within 10 feet of your paintball marker. To offer surrender, yell "SURRENDER!" Your opponent does not have to accept your offer, but you are required to ask them to surrender. Your opponent is free game to shoot if they do not accept your offer within a reasonable time (i.e., you can't yell "surrender" and then fire before they have a chance to respond).

Stop shooting

Once an opposing player has been hit, do not continue to shoot them. The designated "I've been hit" signal is to put your gun over your head pointed to the sky. If you see someone raising their gun up in this fashion, they are dead and no longer free game to shoot. If you are caught shooting a dead man you will be removed from the game and will not be allowed to play for the rest of the day.

Shoot 285 FPS or less

Keep paintball velocities under 285 feet per second (FPS). All paintball markers will be tested at the beginning of the day to verify that they are not shooting higher than 285 FPS. Tampering with your velocity after being tested is prohibited.

Manual Fire Only

If your marker is equipped with multiple-burst or automatic fire modes, you must set them to single-fire mode. You may fire as fast as your finger(s) can pull the trigger, but no automatic fire is allowed.

Use barrel covers

Unless you're in a game, your marker needs to have a barrel cover on. Safeties are good and should be used, but they often fail or are not properly used, and a physical protection from wayward paintballs is a must.

Common sense

Most problems can be avoided if you just use common sense. Don't shoot private property. Don't look down the barrel of a loaded gun. Don't shoot yourself, etc. If you have to ask if something might be a good idea, it's not.

Don't take off your mask

This has already been said, but needs repeating: **DO NOT REMOVE YOUR MASK UNTIL YOU'VE REACHED THE DESIGNATED SAFE ZONE!** Most severe injuries can be avoided if players simply keep their masks on.
