



## Chanco Parish Representative Program (CPR) **YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE!**

### Job Responsibilities:

- Make no mistake about the name of your job—**CPR**. Your help will continue to “breathe the spirit” into our youngsters to participate in Camp Chanco. The CPRs have made a large impact on camp numbers already! The last two summers for Chanco have been record-breaking, in large part due to the Chanco Reps’ efforts! Your task is to spread the word of Chanco’s camp programs and thus cause more youth to become campers in our residential sessions and out trips. The Board of Directors believes that this effort is needed to heighten the awareness of our treasure on the James. Thank you, in advance, for your time, dedication, and effort! Chanco could not exist without people like you! With gratitude to those who are willing to serve, the Board has approved a \$200 Camp discount for you to use for your child or to give to another.
- You will be responsible for contacting your parish priest or other staff member and **scheduling a Chanco Open House**. Ideally, this Open House will be held during the Sunday School hour to achieve maximum attendance and should be held sometime between January 15 and April 15th (later than this and many families have already made their summer plans). If absolutely necessary, a late April or May open house could be held, though this is not ideal.
- Prior to the Open House, you need to advertise your Camp Open House via your bulletin inserts, parish newsletter, and announcements. Talk with your rector to determine if there are any discretionary funds available to “raffle” money toward a tuition at your open house. If you are able to secure this, advertise that this will be offered.
- At the Chanco Open house you will give a brief summary of what Camp Chanco offers and how it has affected your life. Feel free to enlist young or teenaged campers to share their experiences as well! You will show the DVD summarizing camp and the Summer 2009 DVD of pictures from last summer. You will hand out the 2010 Chanco fliers and **highlight the Open House at Chanco on April 18th from 1-5pm and on May 1st from 9am-5pm** as an introductory camp experience. You will share your own/your camper’s experience at Chanco and if youth attend, may play some Chanco games! You will answer any questions (FAQ and Camp Director’s answers are included in your packet). **You will collect names/addresses of those who attend your open house to send to the CPR Coordinator in order for Chanco to send them more information.**
- After the Open House, you should follow up with any interested persons who may have questions about camp. Talley Banazek, CPR Coordinator, will provide you with information for insertion in parish bulletins and newsletters periodically throughout the year.
