

Sailing Camps

GREETINGS MATE! This is to help you know what to expect and what to bring to camp. The Beginner Mariner's Camp is a basic course in sailing. We assume your sailing experience to be at the novice level or less. Come prepared for total immersion (knowledge, not water). You will learn nomenclature, knots, safety, rules of the road, racing tactics, and more.

The Mobjack Camp will be a bit more advanced for those who have already gotten the basics. We will be sailing larger vessels and learn more about adventuring on the water.

Come prepared for lots of sun and water and fun. Sunscreen, sunglasses, and two or three quick-dry swimsuits are a must! Listed below are your other equipment needs for Sailing Camps:

- Sleeping Bag (light as possible)
- Poncho or Rainsuit
- Mosquito repellent (non-aerosol)
- Flashlight and Extra Batteries
- Toilet Articles
- Towels, Washcloth, & Soap
- Suntan Lotion (#45 or higher filter)
- Hat with Brim (one that can get wet)
- Safety Cord to tie Glasses
- Rustproof whistle with lanyard
- 2 pr. tennis shoes
- 6 pr. socks
- 1 pr. watershoes or canvas shoes (ones that will stay on in water - no flip-flops)
- 4 bandanas
- 4-8 days underwear
- 5 pr. shorts
- 1 or 2 lightweight washable long pants
- 2 Long sleeve shirts, lightweight
- 1 Long sleeve shirt, heavy, or light jacket
- 1 Set sheets
- 5 T-shirts
- 2 sweatshirts/warm clothes
- Notebook and pens/pencils
- Soft duffel bag or backpack for overnight camping
- 2 - 3 Quick dry one-piece swimsuits
