So what would I be doing for 20 hours per week?

- Understanding and implementing the tree sculpture Business Plan in collaboration with the Youth Tree Mafia (Leadership Team)
- Creating inspiring, high impact, creative workshops for the target market (could range from high school groups to corporations, to not-for-profit organizations) initially, and then managing a program of these workshops
- Recruiting and then managing a team of workshop volunteers
- Actively promoting the program through a range of mediums to a variety of organisations as outlined in the Business Plan
- Managing the financial responsibilities of the program
- Managing relationships with the various stakeholders related to the program (participating organisations, volunteers, relevant government departments)
- Evaluating and developing the program on an ongoing basis in collaboration with the Youth Tree Mafia and in response to participant feedback and consultation

The successful applicant will be:

- Passionate about creating social change through social enterprise.
- Passionate about youth innovation and volunteering
- Self-motivated, entrepreneurial, and independent
- Knowledgeable of business practices, finance and legal issues regarding business, and incredibly interested in researching these and teaching themselves new skills
- In possession of people management skills and experience
- Someone with integrity, professionalism and attention to detail
- Happy to collaborate with and learn from others, share ideas, expertise and workload
- Passionate about using their abilities and skills to better people and the world

Please Note: This not an exhaustive position description. It is a suggestion of the areas you will be involved in and could certainly change. Youth Tree is a dynamic environment and Youth Tree staff will need to be flexible, self-motivated, creative, willing to take ownership of their position and willing to try new things. Hence Youth Tree values people with:

- A sense of humour
- A genuine desire to do good in the world
- Attention to detail
- Humility
- Creativity (creativity doesn't mean you have to be good at painting... it's very broad)
- An interest and fascination in the world and in their own field of work
- Persistence and patience
- Genuine friendliness, willingness to share and collaborate
- Love of stupidity and an uncanny willingness to participate in cartwheel contests etc at formal events
- A willingness to be a leader
