DAY 01

Arrive at JFK airport. You will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel in Manhattan. Check in to the hotel after 3 PM (requests for early check in are at the hotel's discretion and subject to availability at the time of arrival).

Meet your tour director at 7 pm in the hotel lobby to start the tour. Enjoy a sumptuous buffet dinner at an Indian restaurant (walking distance). After dinner, spend time at Times Square, a busy and famous spot in the heart of New York City, also known as the "Crossroads of the World". Return back to the hotel. Overnight in New York City.




DAY 02

Take a ferry ride from Battery Park to the Statue of Liberty Park and visit the famous Statue of Liberty. In the afternoon, have an international lunch (on your own).

Later, make a quick stop at Wall Street before visiting One World Trade Center, the tallest skyscraper in the Western Hemisphere and built on the site of the original World Trade Center complex. Take the express elevators to the Observation Deck on the 102nd Floor for the ultimate view of the spectacular New York City skyline.

Go on a tour of the city with our experienced hop-on tour guide. Make a photo stop at Ground Zero (entrance to the 9/11 memorial is not included). Drive by Rockefeller Center, a famous Art Deco NYC landmark located in the heart of Midtown. Enjoy the famous views and the ambience of the bustling districts of Times Square, Greenwich Village, SoHo, Little Italy, and Brooklyn Bridge. Visit the Apple Store on Fifth Avenue.

In the evening, enjoy a sumptuous dinner at an Indian restaurant before returning to the hotel for overnight stay.



DAY 03

Get an early start to your day after breakfast and depart for Philadelphia (2 hours). Upon arrival, enjoy an entertaining tour of the city. See the city's important sites and landmarks as your expert guide mixes fun and history into an interactive tour experience. After lunch in Philadelphia, drive to National Harbor near Washington D.C. 


DAY 04

DAY 05

After breakfast at the hotel, tour the State Capitol of Pennsylvania in downtown Harrisburg, which is often referred to as a "palace of art" because of its many sculptures, murals and stained-glass windows (Guided tour is subject to availability and timing). Next, visit Hershey's Chocolate World and experience the very enjoyable Hershey's Great American Chocolate Tour Ride.

Drive to Corning to check out the world's most comprehensive Glass collection at the Corning Museum of Glass.



DAY 06

Experience the unforgettable Maid of the Mist boat tour, America's most amazing boat ride since 1846! See the raging currents and hear the deafening thunder as you get close to the Falls. Get up close and personal with the Falls with the Cave of the Winds trip, where you will gear-up in a souvenir rain poncho and follow wooden walkways to the Hurricane Deck (do not forget to take extra pair of clothes). In the evening, spend free time on own before enjoying a sumptuous dinner at an Indian restaurant. Overnight in Niagara Falls.

There will be no vehicle available for today as the hotel and restaurant are at an easy walking distance to the park.





DAY 07

After breakfast at the hotel, check out of the hotel before 11AM and transfer to Buffalo airport for your departure.

Domestic/International flights are not included in the tour cost. Travelers are free to book their flights on own with any airline of their choice. Arrive in New York JFK before 4 pm. Departure from Buffalo International airport (BUF) can be anytime in the morning (hotel checkout time is 11 am).



PRICING

Price per guest is based on accommodation for two adults in a double room.

Single travelers have to pay a \$500 single room supplement to ensure a private room.

Three or four adults sharing a room will receive a 8% reduction in the tour price.

Children under 2 years of age travel free.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION

Booking: A deposit of \$250 per person is required to confirm your booking. The remaining balance must be paid at least 15 days prior to your tour departure date.

Cancellation: Reservations can be changed or cancelled at no charge, up to 15 days before the scheduled tour date. No refunds will be provided for cancellations made within 15 days of tour departure.

COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

Guests are required to wear face coverings or masks while on the Tour and in Public spaces, and strictly observe social distancing at all times.

Tour Manager will check guests' body temperature at least once a day.

Hotels, Restaurants, and Attractions have their own COVID-19 guidelines, and guests are expected to adhere to their rules and guidelines.

Guests will be provided with hand sanitizer (one bottle for the entire tour) and disposable masks (one per day).

Guests exhibiting symptoms indicative of COVID-19 will not be allowed to continue on the tour and are required to immediately contact their health insurance company for assistance.

MINIMUM GUEST COUNT

If a departure does not have at least 6 paid guests at 15 days prior to the tour date, guests booked on the tour will be given the option to reschedule their booking to a future scheduled departure date at no charge.

Alternatively, guests may choose to cancel their booking and receive a full refund (including the booking deposit of \$250 per person).

VEHICLE

If a departure has less than 15 guests, the tour will be conducted in a large van by the driver who will also perform the role of a tour manager.

- The opening and closing dates for the Maid of the Mist boat ride depends on ice conditions. Please check the latest operating schedule online at www.maidofthemist.com
- Guests need to wear masks upon entering the vehicle for their pick up and drop-off from/to the airport.
- For the comfort of all Guests, we request that you travel light (recommended luggage: One carry on and One International size suitcase.)
- All the hotels/restaurants/attractions confirmed for this tour comply to COVID guidelines as mandated by CDC. Guests will have to follow the rules when in premises of respective hotels.
- Check in time at hotels is 3 pm while the check out is 11 am. If guests want to extend their stay, they can contact the front desk and request them.
- Porterage/Baggage Handling is not a part of the tour. If guests require this service, they can contact the bell desk at respective hotel and pay on own.
- Our Tour manager will meet the group in the hotel lobby at 6 pm.
- We have couple of locations where restaurants are walking distance from the hotel. Guests who are not keen on walking can take an Uber or a cab to the destination on own.
- Wheelchair passengers, if planning on joining our tour will need to have someone travel with them to assist the passengers. Tour manager will be unable to provide aid. Also, please note that our vehicles are not equipped for handicapped travelers.
- Seating Arrangement in the vehicle will be first come first serve. The coach size will vary based on the number of guests. This can be 15 seater/25 seater/30 seater/55 seater. For van tours below 15 guests, we will have Driver/Tour leader.
- We are not responsible for lost Valuables/Travel documents. We request the guests to take care of their personal belongings.
- Guests are liable to pay for any damages caused while on tour either at the hotel they are staying in, in the vehicle or at restaurants and attractions. We will collect the valued amount before the end of the tour.
- Hotels in New York and Las Vegas will ask for a credit card at the time of check in towards incidentals. The hotel usually puts a hold on the credit card and this hold will be released if no expenses are incurred. It usually takes anywhere from 2-3 weeks for the charge to disappear on the Credit statement. Make sure to get a Zero statement balance from the hotel. If paying cash to the front desk, please make sure to collect the same before checking out.
- If guests are planning to deviate from the scheduled tour plan (to meet friends, etc), this must be mentioned clearly in the email and acknowledged by OpenWinds.
- Because of the current scenario, all breakfast and dinner will be Ala Carte and brought to the table. We request guests to follow the guidelines of the restaurant.
- The weather can vary considerable depending on the month of travel. Please make sure to have weather appropriate clothing. Walking shoes are recommended. Also remember to carry an umbrella since it can rain any time of the year.
- Tour leader has the right to change the itinerary based on Weather and traffic conditions. Please follow protocol while on tour. In case of any breakdown, we will try our best to fix the problem. However, no monetary compensation will be provided.
- Standard room is with King bed. For 2 or more passengers (maximum occupancy is 4 per room), we will book a room with two double beds. For parents traveling with children, we will book a room with 2 beds. Rollaway beds are not allowed in a room with 2 beds.
- Our Pricing for the hotels includes room rate, taxes and Breakfast if applicable. The passengers are liable to pay for any additional incidentals that they may incur at the hotel.
