TOPIC: The Mighty Men of David TEXT: 2 Samuel 23:8

Introduction: David was called "a man after God's heart". He was the only character whose name had the highest mention in the Bible aside Jesus Christ. His popularity brought him into trouble with Saul who as at first believed in his ministry as a Warrior. He accomplished greatly for the Lord in his time. Down through the ages, whenever God has done a significant work, He has done it through a band of committed people. God doesn't work through the lukewarm, but only through those who are fervent in their love for Christ and His kingdom.

This was the case when David's kingdom was established. Through David's reign, the name of the Lord God of Israel was published far and abroad. But great as he was, David did not stand alone. Surrounding him were a band of mighty men who accomplished great feats of valor. They were committed to David and his kingdom. We read of them in 2 Samuel 23:8-39.

While David was getting close to the end of his reign as King over Israel, he reflected on his ministry as a King, a shepherd and warrior. He knew and understand his impotency, failures and weaknesses and attributed the achievements to God (11 Sam 23: 5). It was in this light that he mentioned his men which he had. These men are in categories but we will only consider "David's mighty men".

If God is going to accomplish a great work among us, then He wants to raise up a band of mighty men in our midst who can do great exploits for God. In saying "mighty men," mighty women are not excluded, but the emphasis is the need for strong men of faith. While the Bible teaches the equality of the sexes in personhood and in standing before God, it also teaches that God has ordained different roles for the sexes (1 Cor. 11:3; 1 Tim. 2:8-15). The New Testament makes it clear that God desires men to be in spiritual leadership in the home and church. The church today--this church--needs a band of mighty men like these who surrounded David.

Our study will surround the following questions:

- 1. Who are these David's mighty men?
- 2. What are their characteristics?
- 3. What distinguishes them to be mighty among other men?
- 4. What are the lessons learnt from these men?

Who are these men? 11 Samuel 23: 8 - 22

Their names	Their Acts/Exploits		
Adino the Eznite - verse 8,	 Chief among the Captains He lifted up his spear against eight Hundred and slew them at once. 		
Eleazar, the son of Dodo - verse 9 - 10	 One of the three mighty men Smote Philistines until his hands was weary and his hand clave unto the sword 		
Shammah the son of Agee the Hararite Verse 11 - 12	 He stood where others fled and defended the land He slew the Philistines that made people fled 		
Abishai, the brother of Joab - Verse 18	 Chief among the next three. He lifted up his spear and slew three Hundred Philistines 		
Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, the son of a valiant man	 He had background of valiancy. He slew two Lion-like men of Moab He confronted and conquer a man with spear with only his staff 		

These five men were chosen to be mighty men among thirty men of David. The first three had common trait of daring death to get water for David from the well of Bethlehem while David was in the cave of Adullam. 11 Sam 23: 13–17.

What are their characteristics? 1. They were all attracted to Da

- They were all attracted to David despite diverse background 2 Sam. 21:15-17
- They were men of difficult backgrounds 1 Samuel 22:2

What distinguishes them to be mighty among other men?

What are the lessons learnt from these men?

David's men were not unwilling conscripts who grimly fulfilled their duty. They were willing volunteers who served out of devotion to David. The love these men had for David can be seen in the incident described in 23:13-17. David was hiding from Saul in the cave of Adullam. The Philistines were in Bethlehem, David's home town. David thought back to the cool, clear water which he used to drink from the well in Bethlehem as a boy. So, perhaps without thinking, he exclaimed, "Oh that someone would give me water to drink from the well of Bethlehem which is by the gate!" (23:15).

1. Attraction to their Master

The first mark of a mighty man in the Lord's Church is that he is attracted to, captivated by, the person of the Lord Jesus. Our relationship with the Captain of our souls should be marked by devotion not duty.

2. Commitment to the cause

A commitment which overcomes the odds with faith in God. Note 23:8, 9–10, 11–12, 18, 21 (a 71/2 foot giant, according to 1 Chron. 11:23). In every case these mighty men faced insuperable odds. But note 23:10, 12: "the Lord brought about a great victory." These men weren't considering the odds for victory; they were looking to the God of victory.

3. Determination to win and numbered among the best.

These men made up their mind despite their humble beginning to win the race and be numbered among the best. 1 Corinthian 9: 25 – 26; Daniel 1: 5 -6



A list of the bravest of them is given in 1stChronicles 12, with which you can compare 2nd Samuel 23:13 and 1st Chronicles 11:15.

God is looking for men and women who though having faults, are not afraid of the process needed to recreate them into "mighty men of God." He uses various means to produce such an army so that he can:

- Accomplish His objectives
 - Establish a real and living Godly faith in His children and in the world
 - Separate His children from the things that ensnare them (fear, lust, pride etc.)
