In the month of October, we will start our Ball Study. Children love balls. They play with them in different ways. They throw them, catch them, kick them, and roll them with seemingly endless delight. Children learn how natural forces, such as gravity and friction, affect the movement of balls. They also enjoy making balls, marbles, and other rolling objects change speed and direction.

This study shows how to use children's interest in balls to help them explore social studies and science concepts related to the features and nature of balls, and to use skills in literacy, math, technology, and the arts as they investigate.

Language and literature

We will be extending our vocabulary with new words related to our study, we will introduce letter recognition of our names, and practice writing our names independently. We will also be introducing books and stories related to our study.



Math

Through daily discussions we will continue practicing counting from 1-20, one-to-one correspondence, comparing and measuring, introducing 3D shapes and geometrical shapes .We will also continue with classification concepts.

We will study the concept of “cause and effect” using balls, building blocks, art and experimenting with them.
