HALLOWEEN WITCH'S HAT

What You Need

- Template on following pages
- White paper or card to copy template.
- Scissors and glue stick.
- Thick black marker.
- Bright watercolour paints
- Paintbrush

To prepare

 Print templates below. These have been created as smaller artworks, not for wearing. If you want to create wearable hats enlarge the templates as much as you can.

The Project

- Cut out templates. Cut all solid lines and fold on dotted lines.
- Lay recycled paper or newsprint down to protect the table from paint.
- Use the black marker to draw random crossing lines across both shapes.
- Use watercolours to paint each of the white areas formed by the black lines then leave to dry.
- Put glue on tab, twist paper into a cone shape and glue 2 edges together.
- Place on table with small tabs folded out.
- Put glue on back of ring shape then pop it over the cone and press down onto tabs to firmly glue the hat brim in place.

To display

 They look terrific when the brim is glued to black card and displayed on a wall. It's like having a top-down view with the cone facing the viewer to give an interesting 3D effect.

















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
