

# Joshua #4 | Following God-Because He is God and I Am Not Joshua 7

As they set the stones of memorial, we crossed the Jordan from 2022 and entered into the land of 2023. We have been setting stones- not of memorial but of commitment That – an opportunity to see the hand of God work mightily in our own lives in 2023- in a way that we never gave Him opportunity before!

1| Get Your Heart Checked - Read Joshua 7:1-13

Victory OR defeat Many have defeat in areas in their life that they should have victory in. BUT GOD will not bless them because there is something in their heart that needs to be eliminated. Until it is destroyed- they will be continually defeated. How can we find out if something in our life is causing us to have defeat rather than victory?

2| Read Job 31:1 & Psalm 119:37

Whatever you may be struggling with, ask the Lord for help in overcoming it. Another way to overcome sin is to expose it. Is there someone in your life that you can go to for accountability, is there someone who is a trusted friend? How can we find such a faithful person that we can trust with our sins?

3| Your Clock Will Stop - Read Psalm 39:4-5, James 4:14 & Psalm 90:12  
Time management is important because of the brevity of our lives. Our earthly sojourn is significantly shorter than we are inclined to think. As David and James so aptly point out. How does having an eternal perspective help you to move forward with diligence and divine purpose. What does this look like in your life?

4| It's Not Mine - Matthew 6:19-21

Not only does everything you have belong to God, but your very soul belongs to Him as well. He has created you and you were bought with the blood of Jesus Christ.
