

HALLOWEEN SILHOUETTES

What You Need

- White paper sized for the project (you can choose).
- Kid-friendly paint: tempera or finger paint.
- Paint brush.
- Black paper or card.
- White pencil
- Scissors and glue stick



The Project

- Lay down recycled paper or newsprint to protect your table from paint.
- Choose three bright colours for the backdrop and cover the white paper. Actually, they can choose as many colours as they like, as long as they are bright/light so the silhouettes will stand out.
- Leave to dry.
- Use the white pencil to draw Halloween shapes on the black paper/card. Think about how big they need to be to stand out and to fit nicely on the backdrop.
- Cut out the shapes and glue them to the backdrop, keeping any white pencil marks face down so they can't be seen.
