




OStaying Cool in the Librar

- The stories usually teach some type of a lesson





The fables almost always had animal characters who learned a moral or lesson at the end. These stories were shared orally and were told and re-told again and again. "Larger than life" means a person who attracts a lot of attention and is exciting and interesting. How is Pecos Bill "larger than life?"










