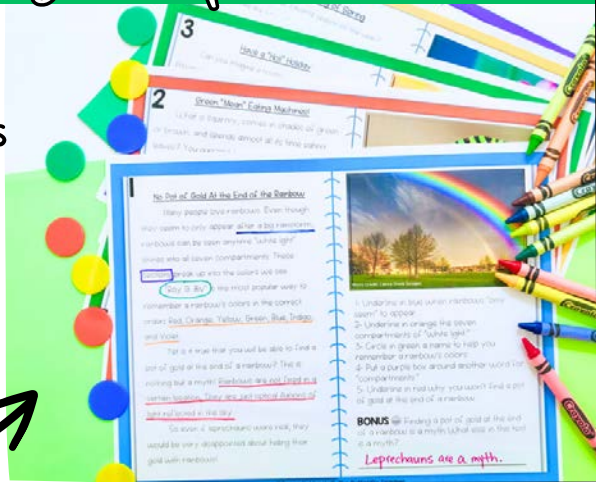

Quick-Reads Improve Reading Comprehension


What is sunny, comes in shades of green, or brown, and spends almost all its time eating

No Pot of Gold At the End of the Rainbow

Many people love rainbows. Even though they seem to only appear after a big rainstorm, rainbows can be seen anytime "white light" shines into all seven compartments. These **compartments** break up into the colors we see. "Roy G. Biv" is the most popular way to remember a rainbow's colors in the correct order: Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Indigo, and Violet.

Yet is it true that you will be able to find a pot of gold at the end of a rainbow? This is nothing but a myth! Rainbows are not fixed in a certain location. They are just optical illusions of light reflected in the sky.

So even if leprechauns were real, they would be very disappointed about hiding their gold with rainbows!

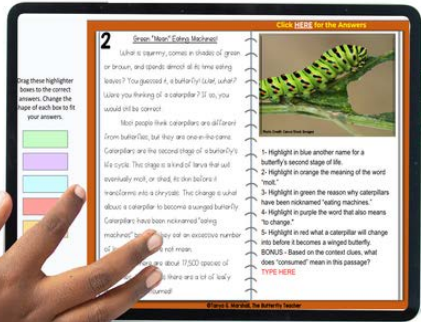

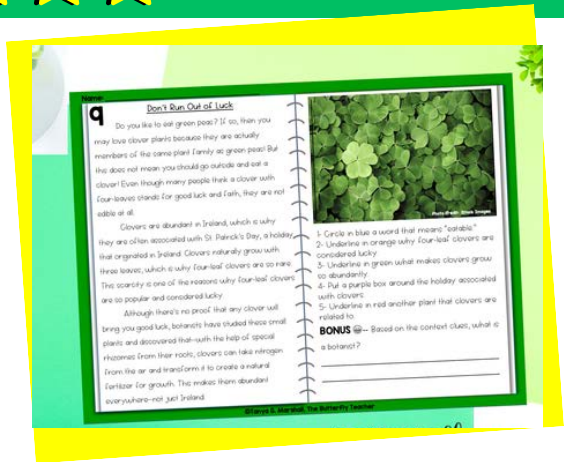

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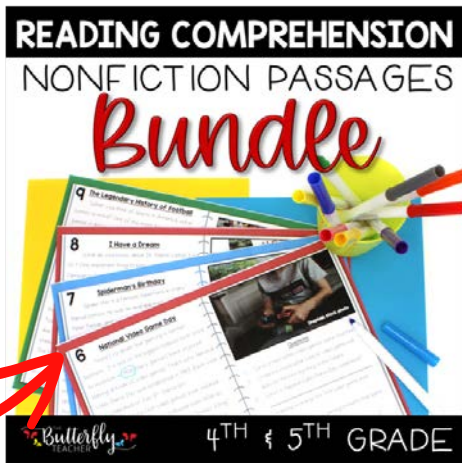
