1. INTRODUCTION

2. BASIC CONTACT DETAILS

From Camp Festival we want to promote the independence and autonomy of the attendees, that is why visits to the camp are not allowed except for the final concert of the last day.

For this reason we propose different ways that you will have to communicate with the camp:

2.1 Daily monitoring of the camp

Through our social networks and WhatsApp group of diffusion, we will go hanging photographs and videos where you can follow the activities your children are doing.

2.2 Call to your home

From the camp phone will be made between 3-4 days a call home where participants can contact their parents/guardians. If there is no answer, we will try to find another time. We ask that these calls do not last more than 2-3 minutes.

2.3 Contact with the camp

Questions or requests may arise during the camp. Please do not interrupt the daily activity, the contact occurs via email to info@campfestival.cat where we will have access every day.

4. TRANSPORT AND ARRIVAL AT THE CAMP

4.1 Arrival/Return

The reception of the participants takes place on 29 june from 16:00, at which time all the instructors and teachers will be present. The first activity scheduled will be the snack and will start at 18:00.

The last day will be held the Final Concert where all families and friends are invited to see their children, feel the deadline pickup time on July 6 at 14:00.

4.2 Transport

Transportation to the camp is not included, each participant has to reach the facilities by their own means. In exceptional cases where the participant comes from far away, you can contact us regarding this issue.

5.3 How to register:

To register for the camp you must first fill in the registration form on the website and once you have received a confirmation email, make the payment of the reservation of €200, sending us the voucher to registration@campfestival.cat.

Once the payment has been made, you will receive a second Welcome email confirming the registration. During the weeks before the camp, we will inform all families via email of the most important information (documentation, second payment, what to bring.)

5.5 Cancellation policy

Once registered in the camp and made the payment of the reservation (200€), this is not refundable. In the event of cancellation due to force majeure (serious illness, illness of a first/second degree relative, attendance at examinations.), you will be entitled to a bonus in the amount of the amounts paid to use it the following year, or a refund, discounting the amount of the reservation.

6. LANGUAGE

The official communications of Camp Festival (mails and web) are made Catalan, so if you do not understand Catalan and you need us to communicate with you in another language (Spanish or English), let us know.

During the camp we have a bilingual team that speaks both Catalan/Spanish and English.

Music doesn't understand languages, so if you're from outside, don't become a barrier to coming to enjoy Camp Festival!

7. PROGRAMME OF ACTIVITIES

The camp has a General Coordinator and a Leisure Director to coordinate the different teams. The team of monitors is responsible for the leisure activities of the camp and for watching over the boys and girls (wake them up, go to sleep, control meals, accompany them to classes and activities, etc). Each monitor is responsible for a group of up to 10 boys and girls as indicated by the current leisure regulations.

The team of teachers is responsible for organizing music classes that are organized in groups of maximum 8-15 people depending on the type of class, grouped according to the age and previous knowledge of each participant.

Types of activities:

Music classes: Every day will have combo class; sets of different instruments formed by groups of maximum 8 people where the repertoire that will play at the Camp Festival concerts is worked. They will also have complementary classes of musical language, harmony and rhythm that will allow you to perfect and improve with your instrument. The repertoire is of modern music.

Workshops: During the camp we will have guests from the music sector. These workshops have a duration different from that of a regular class and allow to complement the curricular activity of the instrument focusing on a specific musical theme.

Concerts: The stay will be full of concerts where young people can participate as artists or as an audience: Concert of teachers, Open Mic Night, Final Concert open to families...

Games and leisure activities: It would not be a camp but we had a team of monitors ready to make the games and activities more fun.

*The general schedule can be modified on guest days or depending on the type of activities.

8. IN THE CAMP

8.1 Mobile and camera

It is not allowed to use any electronic device at the camp. We want Camp Festival to be a space where your sons/daughters can enjoy free time and outdoor activities, that's why devices like the phone, the camera, the iPad, Ebook... are totally forbidden. (We will make many photos and videos that we will send you to have a good memory).

We ask you to cooperate with us in this regard. Failure to comply with this rule shall be regarded as serious misconduct. If any participant fails to comply, the device will be collected and returned at the end of the camp.

8.2 Food

The kitchen team of the house of colonies La Figuera performs daily all menus according to healthy nutritional criteria.

We have menus adapted in the event that your son/daughter has some kind of allergy or intolerance. In order to have everything ready, we ask you to inform us at the time of registration. It is important for the Kitchen team to specify and specify to the maximum the type of allergy/intolerance.

We request the submission of a medical report signed by a registered physician. No other professional reports will be accepted and no special allowances will be made without the specific report.

8.3 Own instruments

Each participant has to bring their instrument except for the participants who choose the drum and piano specialty. The Classes are held in rehearsal rooms with loudspeakers, microphones, piano, drums and amplifiers to connect the instruments.

Despite having their own material, we recommend drummers to bring their own drumsticks and guitarists and bassists to bring a set of spare strings, pedals if they have, a jack to connect the instrument and their own amplifier (if this is not very bulky).

8.4 Medial care, accidents and diseases

If a participant suffers an illness, accident, or is simply not well, the camp team will contact their guardians as soon as possible to inform and take the necessary measures.

The families of the participants, by accepting the General Conditions of the Online Registration Form, authorize Camp Festival to make appropriate decisions in case of urgency, with knowledge and by medical prescription; in the event of not being able to contact the legal authorities and needing urgent intervention the indications legally required by the medical officer of the health centre or hospital shall be followed with the relevant written report.

In case of suffering an infectious-contagious disease that could affect the rest of the companions, the legal guardians of the minor will be notified, so that they proceed urgently to come to the camp to find him.

8.5 Medication

If a participant has to carry medication, they must notify our team. To be able to supply the medication it will be essential to bring the medical authorization and explain in detail the hours of the day and the necessary amount to be taken.

We ask that the notification be made as soon as possible in order to facilitate the organization.

8.6 Alcohol, tobacco and drugs

Camp Festival is a healthy and safe space for all participants, so it is completely forbidden for participants to be in possession of any materials or substances not allowed (alcohol, tobacco, drugs...).

Camp workers are subject to the same rule except for tobacco, whereby there will be a time and place allocated for smoking, outside the premises.

Any participant or team member who fails to comply with this rule shall be immediately expelled from the camp.

9. RULES OF COEXISTENCE AND COMMITMENT OF THE PARTICIPANT

9.1 Rules of conduct

We believe that the following rules of conduct or coexistence will help us to provide a safe, well-being and trust environment for all participants, which is why it is mandatory for all tutors and participants who sign the Rules of Coexistence:

A) Respect and comply with the instructions of the team.

At Camp Festival, instructors and teachers are responsible for ensuring the safety and well-being of participants. It is important that you respect their instructions and come whenever you need.

B) Respect the other participants, external activity monitors and staff of the colony house.

It shall be prohibited:

- * Enter the rooms of other participants and instructors/teachers without prior authorization.
- Use inappropriate language (profanity or obscene language).
- Insult or nickname teammates or team.
- Threatening verbally or physically.
- Take things from other participants without permission.

C) Respect the facilities of the house

- Maintain order and cleanliness of rooms and common areas.
- Do not paint or attach stickers to doors, windows or walls in rooms.
- Damage caused consciously will be assumed by the responsible participants.
- D) You may not take or use tobacco (or e-cigarette), alcohol, or other toxic substances (drugs)
- E) Dangerous objects such as knives, knives, fire-crackers, etc., cannot be carried.
- F) It is forbidden to use electronic elements such as mobile phones, iPads, smarwatch or any device that has an internet connection.
- G) It is recommended not to bring valuables: jewelry, watches, etc. In case of loss of these, Camp Festival is not responsible.

H) Use of the pool:

- Always under the supervision of monitors or camp-specific personnel.
- Do not play dangerous water games
- · Follow the security instructions on the premises.
- I) Lost and Found: Take it immediately to the monitors to locate its owner.

9.2 Protocol for dealing with inappropiate behaviour

We consider the following inappropriate behaviors:

- Physical or verbal aggression to participants or monitors. (Bullying)
- Leave the enclosure of the colony house without permission.
- · Carrying and using alcohol or some kind of drug.
- Continuous lack of discipline and respect for the other participants or instructors/teachers.

In the face of these behaviors, the expulsion will be immediate, in this case, the participant or his legal representative will have to assume the transportation costs and the compensations for the damages that may have caused. Nor shall he be entitled to any reimbursement of the price of the camps.

9.3 Protocol for dealing with infringements of the rules of conduct

Any behavior, attitude or situation not provided for in these Rules will be considered by the Coordinator and Director of leisure of the camp. Failure to comply with the rules will entail taking appropriate measures, reserving the right of expulsion. We will contact the guardians as a matter of urgency and if they are not located with the competent authority.

10. OTHER

10.1 Money

Despite not being necessary, on the last day we will provide a mini bar where families can buy a drink to cool off while watching the concert. The mini bar only accepts cash.

10.2 Birthday

If your son/daughter celebrates the birthday during the

camping period, the first day you can leave us a letter or birthday gift to deliver that day.

There is no laundry service so you have to bring enough clothes for each day. We recommend that all participants name their clothing.

12. TO REVIEW BEFORE CAMP

We suggest and recommend that the reading of this guide take place between tutors and participants.

Discuss with your son/daughter the importance of a proper behavior during the room to Camp Festival and the consequences otherwise.

Tell your son/daughter that if she has any problems she can talk to the monitors and teachers.

Tell your child that he/she does not have to carry any prohibited substances or materials.

Discuss with your son/daughter the importance of participating in all activities that are prepared for the camp.

Discuss with your child the importance of caring for and respecting the material, both your own and others.
