evidence standards. The questions featured on these printables contain a mix of recall and higher-order thinking leveled questions. They are designed to give your students practice with reading skills such as:



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

<u>Materials Needed:</u>


- Construction Paper or Colored Printer Paper
- Scissors
- Magazines
- Glue

Instructions:

- As you read <u>Martin's Big Words</u> to your students, point out that each illustration is a college. Explain to students that a collage is a collection of different pieces put logether.
- · Your students will choose one of Martin's "big" words from the book.
- Give each student the printed copy of their collage word to cut out.
- They will use the different variations of this word, plus images cut out from a magazine to create a collage depicting the word chosen.
- All of these cut-outs will be glued onto their colored paper.


