Reflection Points: How does God want me to think, feel, act, and speak because of this truth?

- 1. Am I in a difficult circumstance right now? Can I see how God is using it to advance the Gospel yet? Am I praying and watching for this moment?
- 2. How have my past hardships worked to advance the Gospel? Or have I wasted them in self-pity and as an excuse for evil?
- 3. Who does God have me chained to right now that needs to hear about Jesus? Who do I know who is in a hard place that I have already traveled? How do I help him/her find Jesus and His comfort like I experienced?
- 4. Have I learned the secret of joy in hard circumstances? Say it aloud Whatever! As long as Jesus wins!

Action Points: What am I going to do this week because of this truth?

- 1. **Read:** Philippians 1:19–30 for next week to prepare your soul for church.
- 2. **Reflect** on the following:
 - How is God using my past and present circumstances to advance the Gospel?
 - Do I serve Jesus and the church out of love or envy and selfish ambition?
 - Have I learned the secret of Paul's joy? Whatever! As long as Jesus wins!
- 3. **Memorize: Philippians 1:12 (ESV)**, "I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel..."
- 4. **Share** with another follower of Jesus what you are learning about God, the Bible, Jesus, etc. Help them follow Jesus better in 2024.
