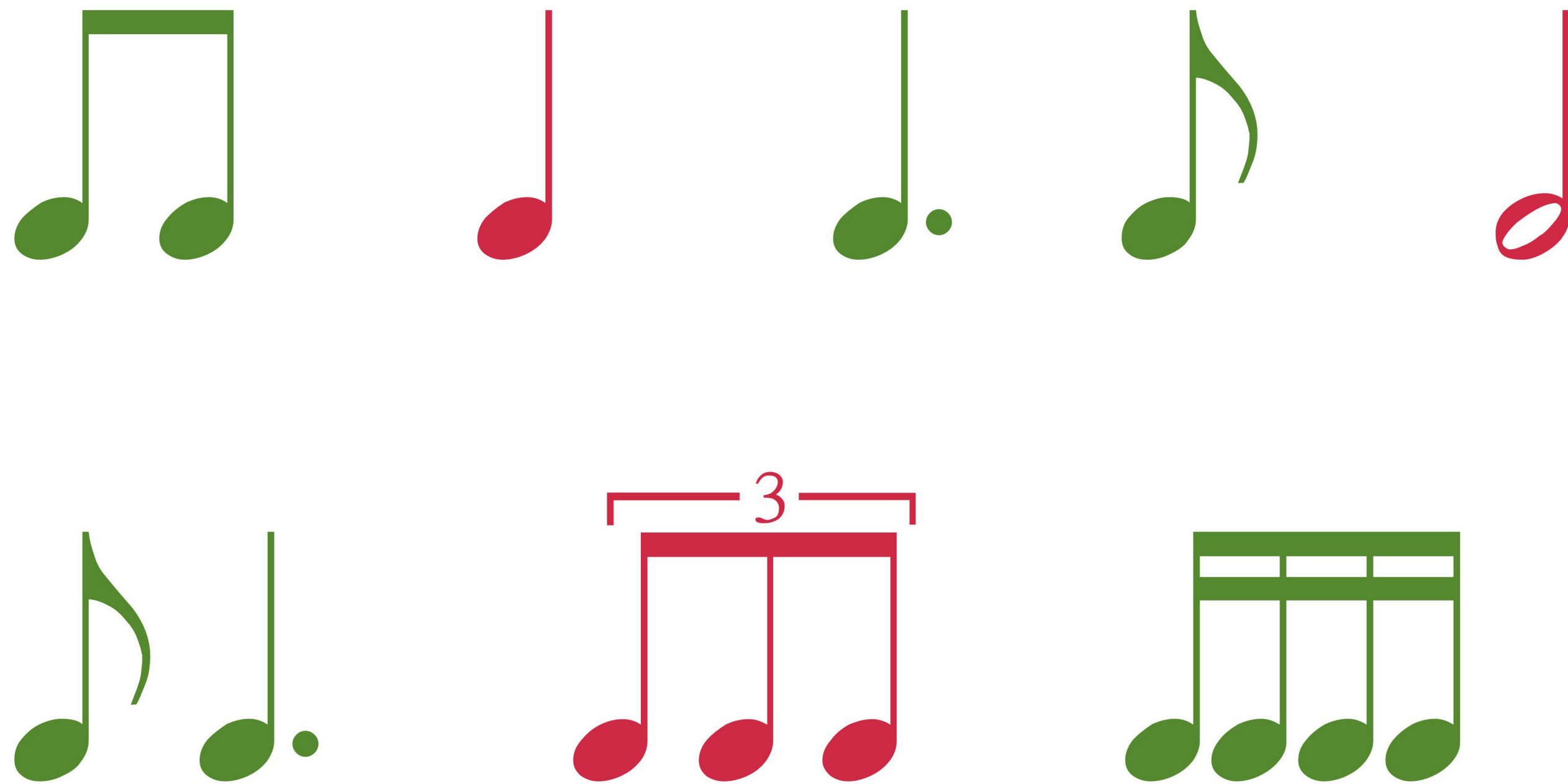


MULTIPLE LEVELS OF CARDS

Picture cards, word cards, and rhythm cards make the rhythms approachable to each student, within their own level of understanding.

7 UNIQUE RHYTHMS

This game nurtures rhythmic understanding of 7 rhythms, expands students' rhythmic fluency, and fosters rhythmic independence.

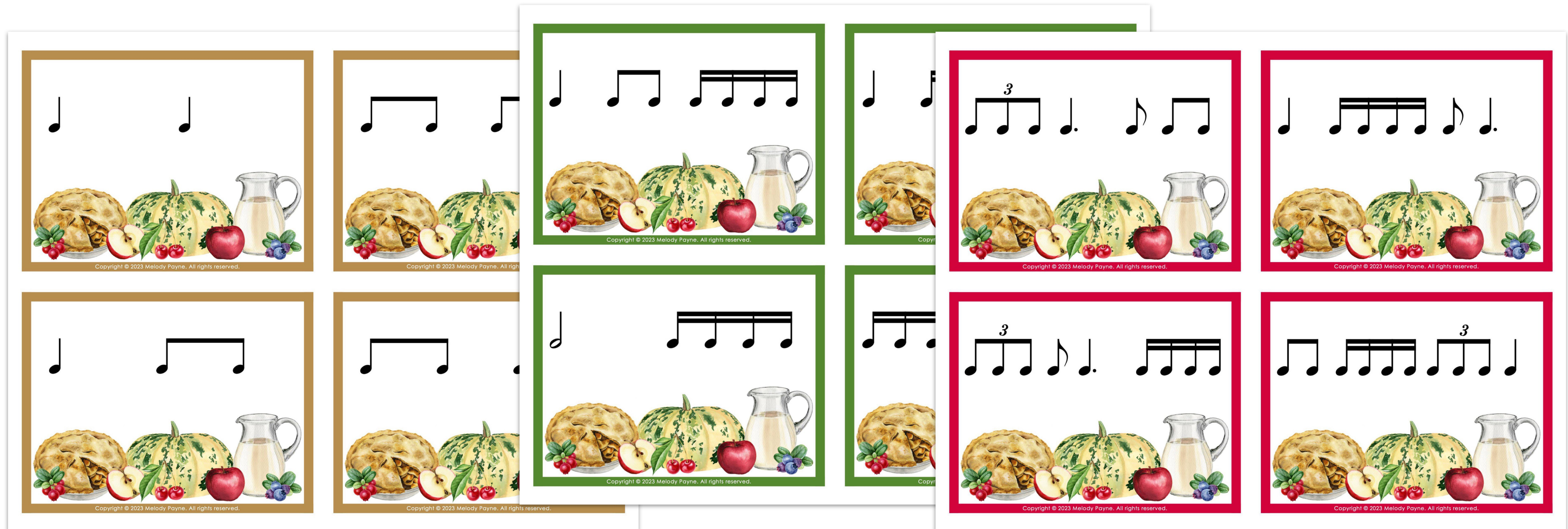


DIFFERENTIATION IS EASY!

3 sets of rhythm cards, in $\frac{2}{4}$ $\frac{3}{4}$ $\frac{4}{4}$.

Cards increase in difficulty within each set.

Perfect for different levels of learning!



Multiple ways to play, for endless fun and fluency!



How to Play, Option 1

1. Choose the rhythm cards that are appropriate for your student's current level. Cards are arranged from easiest to more challenging in this download.
2. The student draws a rhythm card.
3. The student performs the given rhythm on the piano, claps, snaps, body percussion, percussion instrument, cups, etc.
4. If the student performs the rhythm correctly, the student draws a picnic card. The student then rolls the dice and moves forward on the game board.
5. If the student lands on a blueberry, the student draws an activity card.
6. The student should follow the instructions on the activity card.
7. Then the next student takes a turn.
8. The student to reach the finish line with the most picnic cards wins.

How to Play, Option 2

1. The student draws a set number of rhythm cards to build a phrase (2 or 4 cards at a time are suggested).
2. The student then determines the correct time signature for their phrase.
3. The student performs the rhythm.
4. If the student determines the correct time signature and performs the rhythm correctly, the student draws a picnic card. The student then rolls the dice and moves forward on the game board.
5. If the student lands on a blueberry, the student draws an activity card.
6. The student should follow the instructions on the activity card.
7. Then the next student takes a turn.
8. The student to reach the finish line with the most picnic cards wins.

Rhythm phrases foster deeper connections!



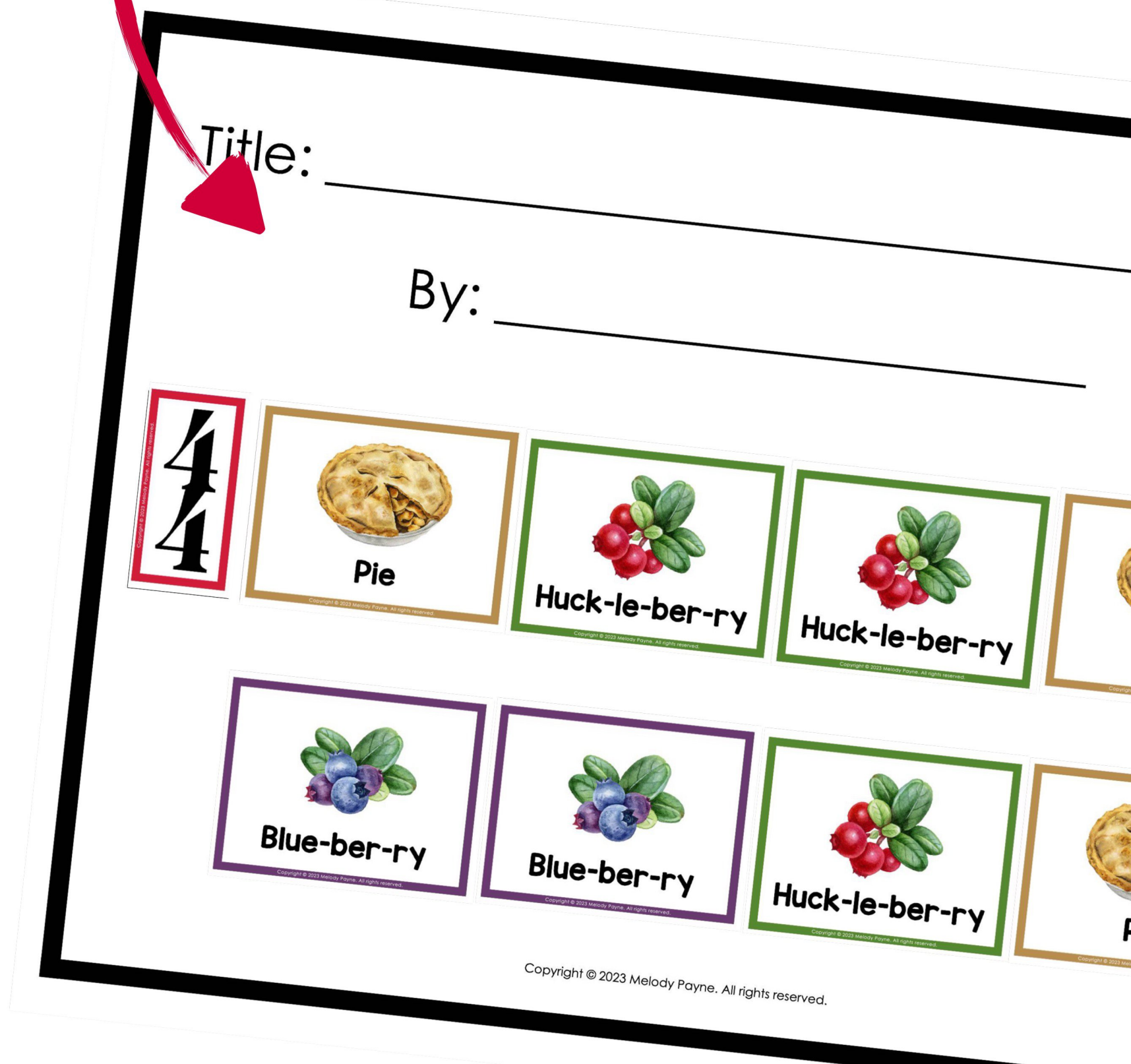
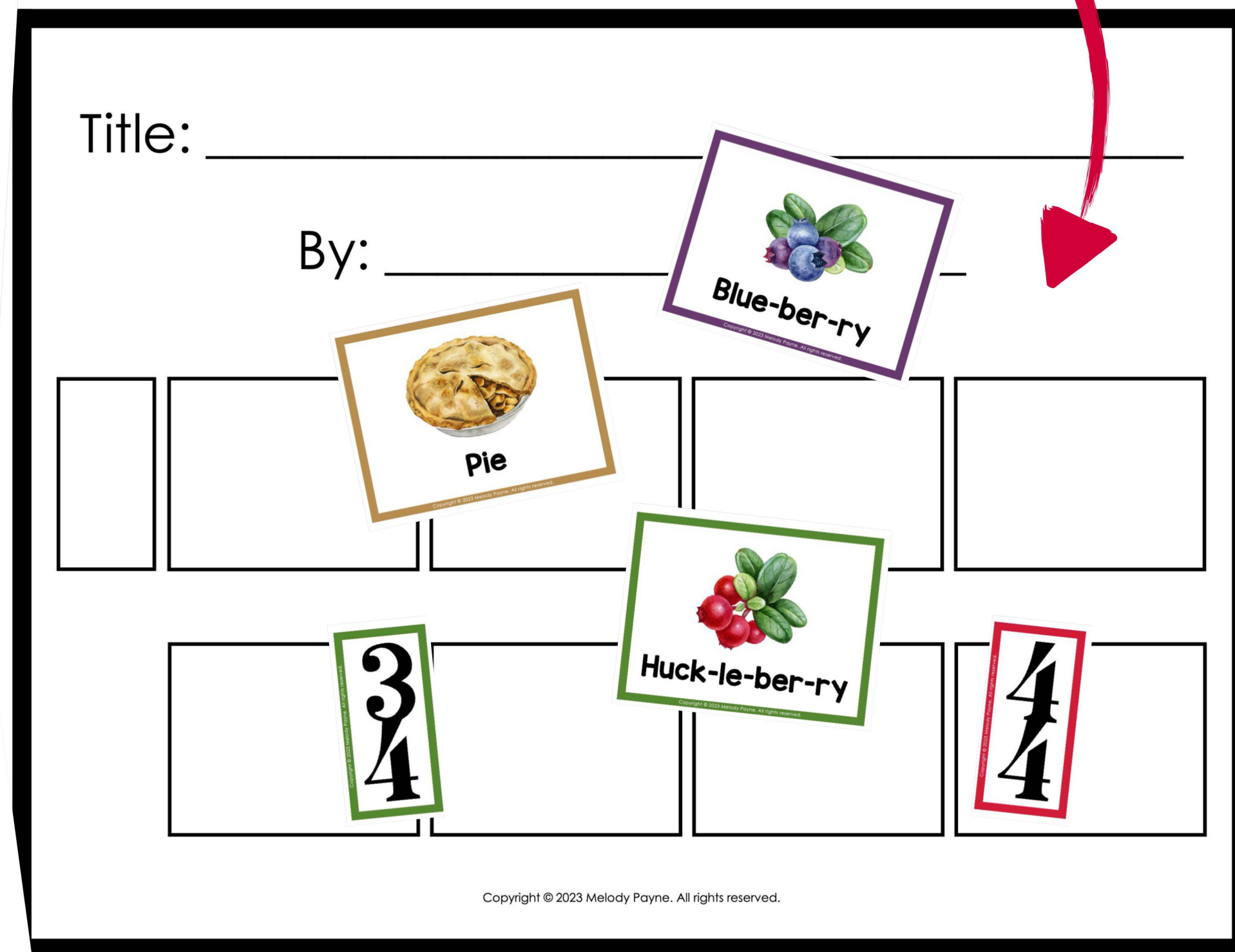
BONUS COMPOSITION ACTIVITY


2. Paste them onto the page

Game Boards and Printing Instructions

The first game board (the one without the poem) can be printed onto a single sheet of paper and used for private lessons.

The second game board (the one with the poem) can be printed poster-sized at home by following the easy tutorial on the pages after the game boards. This poster-sized game board is terrific for group classes!

Game Pieces

1. Print these game pieces onto white card stock.
2. Cut on the solid line. Fold on the dotted lines.
3. Secure the bottom tabs with glue, hot glue, a loop of tape, or double-sided tape.

Assembling the Poster-Sized Game Board

Supplies needed: Paper cutter or scissors and a roll of tape.


1. Place Sheet 1 onto a table.
2. Trim the white edge off of the left side of Sheet 2, place it on top of Sheet 1, and carefully hold the pages in place with one hand and use your other hand to tape them together on the back. Or enlist help from a family member or student to make it a bit easier.
3. Trim the white edge off of the top of Sheet 3 and Sheet 4.
4. Trim the white edge off of the left side Sheet 4.
5. Lay Sheet 3 on top of Sheet 1 and line up the text and gridlines. Tape it on the back.
6. Lay Sheet 4 on top of Sheets 2 and 3 and line up the text and gridlines. Tape it on the back.
7. Press the seams to secure the tape.
8. Carefully flip the poster over.
9. Add more tape to secure the poster.
10. Optional: Place the poster inside a poster frame or tape onto a white poster board or foam board for extra durability.
11. I hope you enjoy this poster-sized game board!
