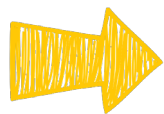

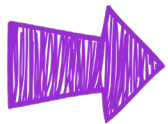

 **Subject search**
This will search the catalog for a specific **SUBJECT**.
This will give you **LESS** search results.
