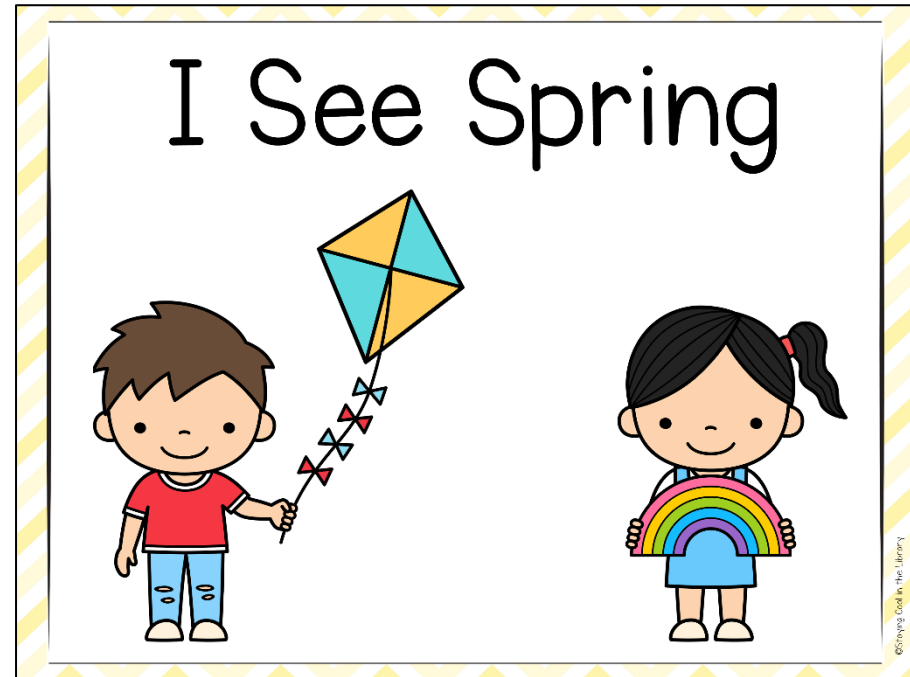


- 2 activities about spring

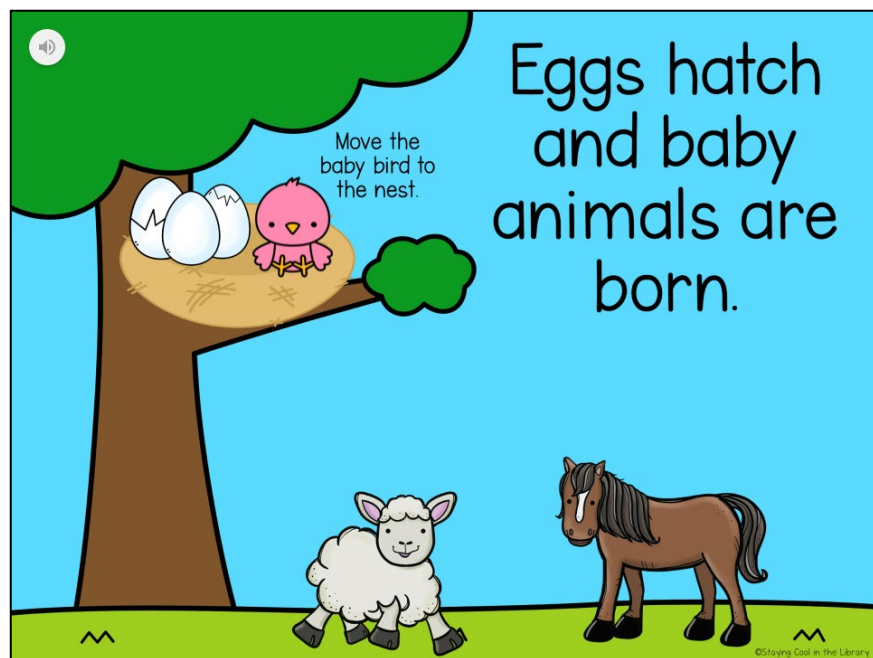
The air warms up. Rain falls
