This game was created off the concept of the new and popular trivia game app, *Trivia Crack*. I have created both a black and white version for ink saving and a color version. I would recommend laminating, especially for the tally mark portion on the Player's Board. This two player game could be placed in a center, used during small groups, or as an early finisher activity.

Students will need the following for the game:

- *Player's Board
- *Character Cards (cards 2 through 9, one for each player)
- *Multiplication Question Cards (sets 2×2 - 9×2 , 2×3 - 9×3 , 2×4 - 9×4 , 2×5 - 9×5 , 2×6 - 9×6 , 2×7 - 9×7 , 2×8 - 9×8 , 2×9 - 9×9)
- *Card Mat
- *Pencil and Paper Clip for spinner

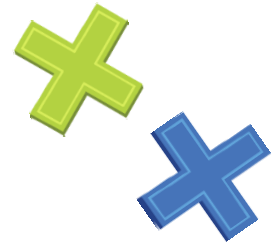
Set Up:

*Take all the cards and sort them. Place all the question cards on their corresponding number upside down. For instance, all the multiplication by two's cards go on the two on the card mat.

*Place all the character cards in a pile.

*Create the spinner using a paper clip and pencil.

*Decide who will be player 1 and who will be player 2.



To Play:

- 1.) Spin the spinner.
- 2.) Where the spinner lands is what card your partner pulls from the card mat under that number.
- 3.) Your partner will read you the multiplication question. You will answer and your partner will check to see if you have it correct.
- 4.) If you have it correct, place a tally mark on the Player's Board in your column (Player 1 or Player 2). If you do not answer correctly, your turn is over and it's your partner's turn. You do not receive a tally mark.
- 5.) It is now your partner's turn to spin. Repeat steps 1-4.

When you have three tally marks, you can pick what character card you would like. Your partner will draw a card from that pile and read you the question. If you answer correctly, you get that character card. If you do not answer correctly, your turn is over and it's your partner's turn. Mark off your character cards so you know which ones you have left to get. The person to get all the character cards first is the winner! Have fun and good luck!

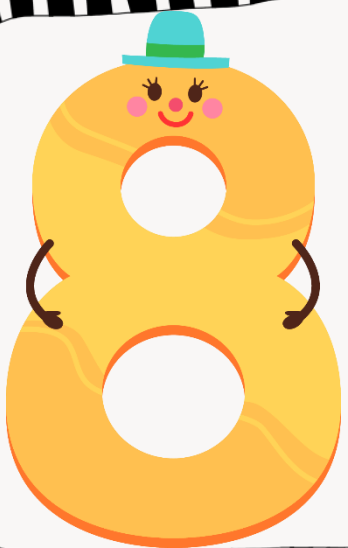
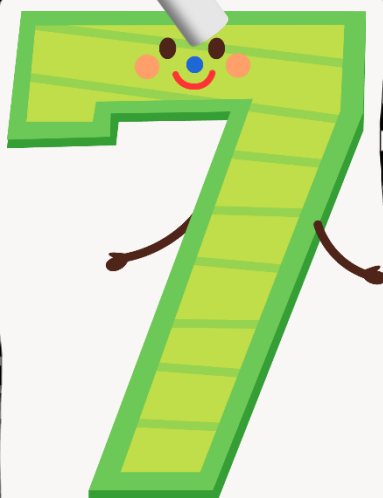
