A Classmate Scavenger Hunt is an activity where students get to talk with their classmates to find out more about them and collect signatures/initials.

These activities are designed to help students spend time with all their friends *(not just their "besties.")*

They also offer a chance to get the wiggles out! Teachers can even participate.

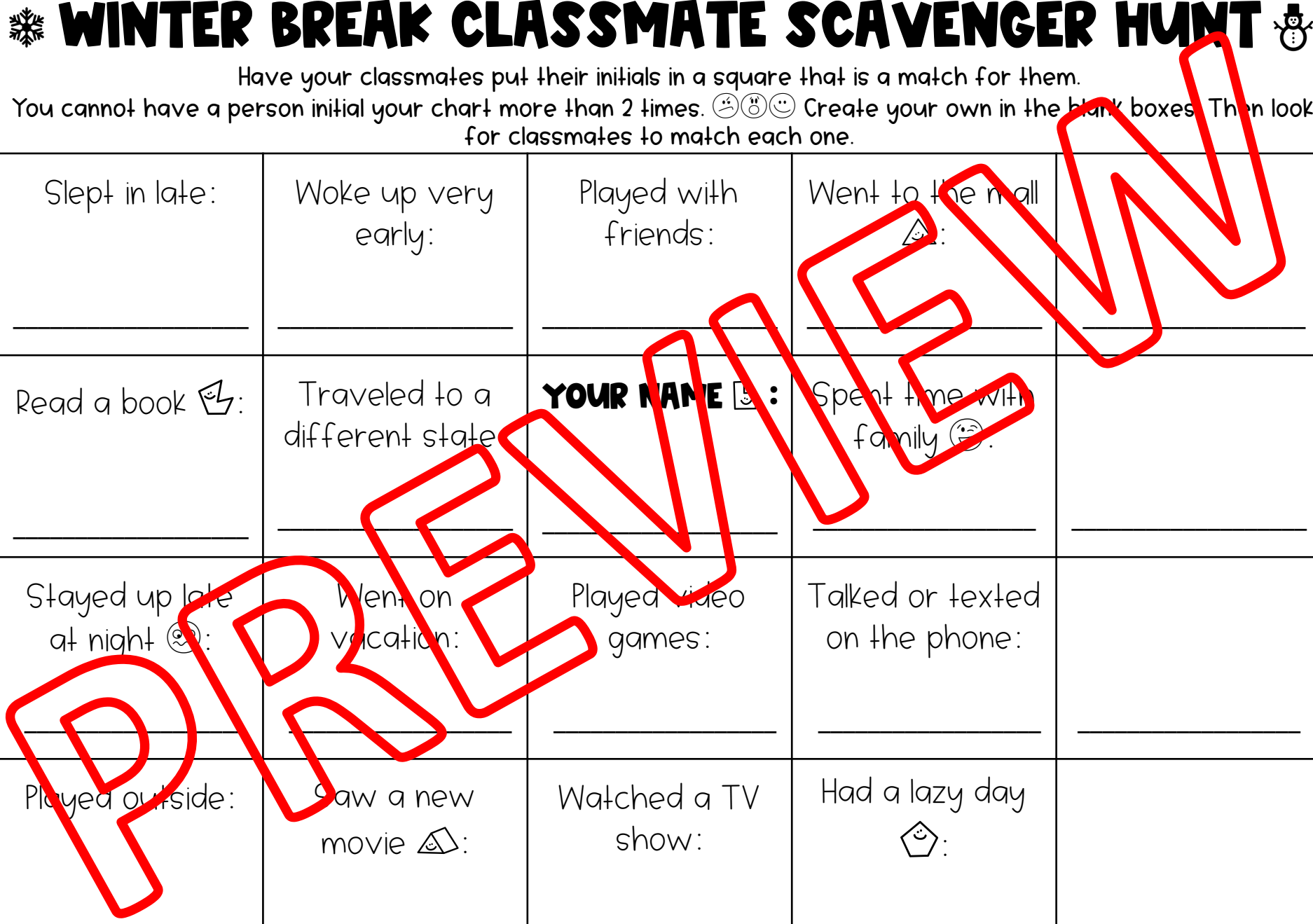
