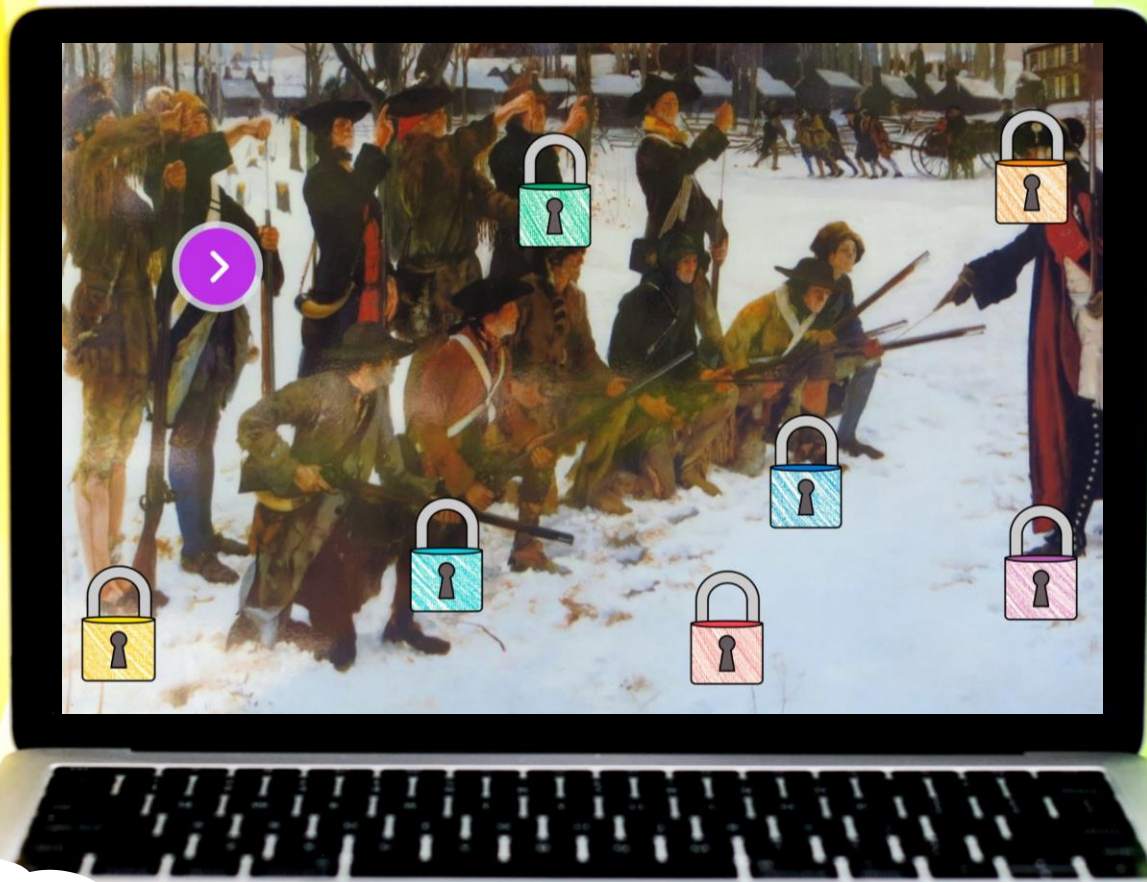



# 6 PASSAGES

Students will read 6 short passages about the topic,  
then answer questions.










General Washington and his estimated 11,000 troops left on December 12 and reached Valley Forge on December 19. Their arrival was delayed by snowstorms. They arrived at Valley Forge six days before Christmas. Valley Forge in Pennsylvania is where the Continental Army set up their camp for six months during the winter of 1777-1778. The British had taken control of Philadelphia and Valley Forge was located about twenty-five miles from there. General Washington wanted to be close enough to the British to keep an eye on them but not too close in case of an attack. Valley Forge was also a strategic location for the army. The Schuylkill River to the north served as a barrier and high mountains surrounding the area allowed the army to build defense walls. Five redoubts (defense walls) were built around the encampment (temporary military huts).
