# READING #1

**HENRY FORD:** Henry Ford was born on July 30th, 1863 in Michigan. From a young age, Ford enjoyed taking things apart to see how they worked and became an engineer at Thomas Edison's Illuminating Company. Edison encouraged him to start engines and build cars.

In 1903, he created the Ford Motor Company. Ford broke the land speed record with his new car named the '99.

The famous Model T was introduced in 1908. The Model T gained popularity because it was easy to drive and cheap to fix.

Later in 1913, Ford developed a moving assembly line. Using an assembly line meant the car would go from one workstation to the next. At each workstation, something different was completed on the car. By 1918, half of all cars in America were a Ford Model T.

Today, Henry Ford is recognized for making affordable cars for people who previously couldn't afford to buy one.

# READING #3

**WRIGHT BROTHERS:** Wilbur Wright was born in 1867 in Millville, Indiana. His brother Orville was born in 1871 in Dayton, Ohio. They are best known for building the world's first successful airplane.

At high school, the brothers started their own newspaper. In 1892 they opened a bicycle repair shop called the Wright Cycle Exchange. They began making airplanes in their bicycle shop. The Wright brothers studied birds to help them design airplanes.

In 1903, they built an airplane called the Wright Flyer I, with wooden propellers and a gasoline engine. After many failed attempts, the plane finally took flight traveling 120 feet before landing. Orville was 32 and Wilbur was 36 when the first flight occurred.

Their father made them promise to never fly together. He was worried about losing both sons in an accident. They only flew together once, on May 25th, 1910.
