


# CAKE MIX

England established colonies, or groups of settlements, along the eastern coast of North America in the 1600's and early 1700's. After the French and Indian War (1756 to 1763), Britain had a massive debt due to the costs of war. Britain now owned much more land and as an effort to rebuild the economy, the British government saw the American colonies as a way to help pay their debts.

# BAKING SODA

In 1765 the British Parliament passed the Stamp Act which imposed taxes on the American colonies. The Act collected a tax on printed goods produced and used within the 13 colonies. In 1767, the Townshend Acts were passed by Parliament and placed taxes on any goods

brought into the colonies. Angry at the taxes, the colonists decided to boycott or refuse to buy.



# FLOUR

In 1773, three British ships named the Dartmouth, the Eleanor, and the Beaver sat in the Boston harbor. Their tea delivery wasn't being unloaded because the colonists of Boston refused to buy or use the English tea. Their anger was directed at Great Britain, which had passed the Tea Act. The Tea Act was a law that required American colonists to



buy their tea from the East India Company. The law lowered prices on tea, however, the Tea Act placed a tax on tea sold by any other company.
