Before the Civil War (1861-1865), slavery was prominent (important) in southern parts of the U.S. After the Civil War, it was no longer allowed to enslave anyone after Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation. The 13th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution declared "that all persons born or naturalized in the United States are, and henceforward shall be, free; and no State shall enter into any new agreement, or amend any existing one, whereby slavery or involuntary servitude, except as a punishment for crime whereof the party shall have been justly convicted and sentenced, shall exist within the Southern states" are, and henceforward shall be free. The 15th Amendments to the U.S. Constitution, passed between 1865 and 1870, gave rights to formerly enslaved people. However, these rights were often denied.
