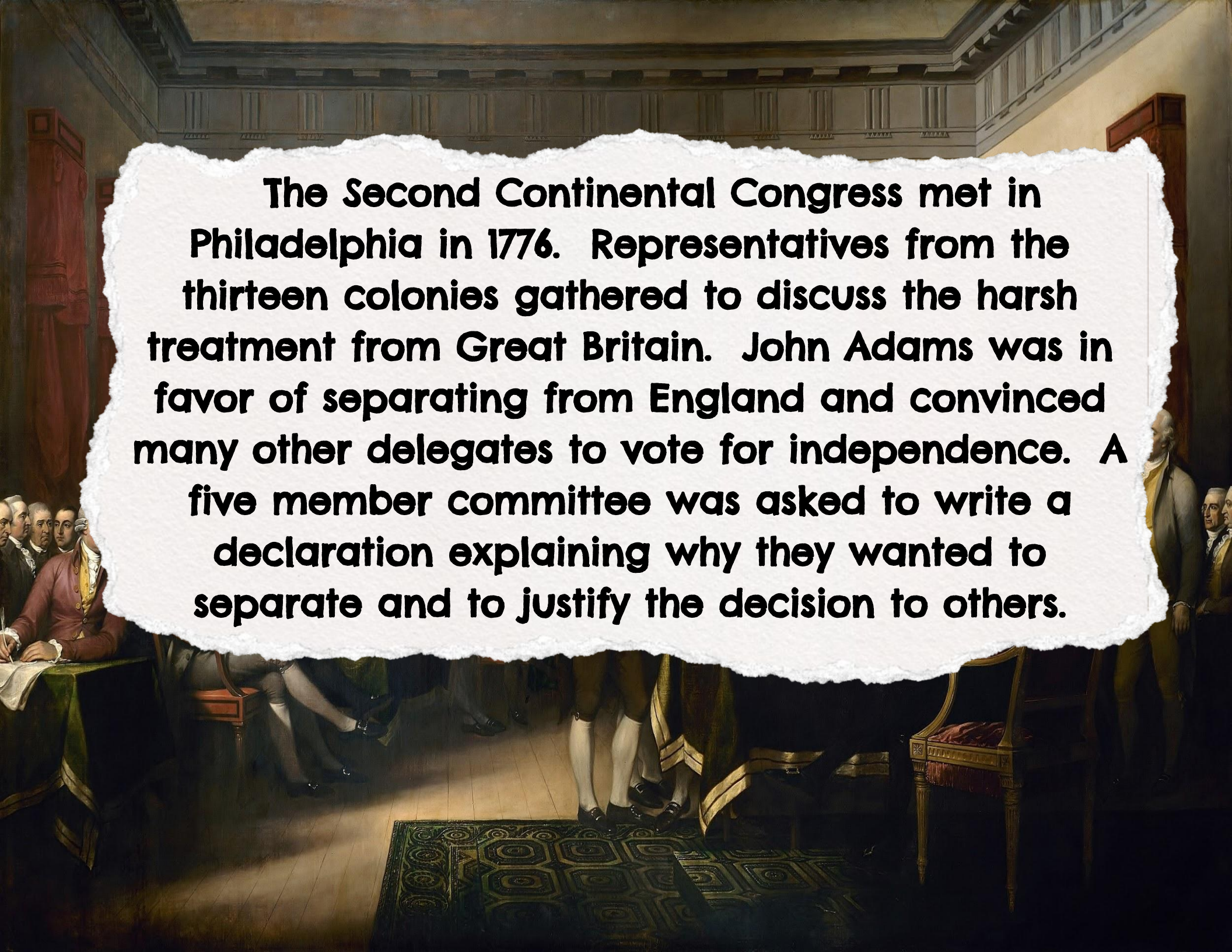

**The Second Continental Congress met in Philadelphia in 1776. Representatives from the thirteen colonies gathered to discuss the harsh treatment from Great Britain. John Adams was in favor of separating from England and convinced many other delegates to vote for independence. A five member committee was asked to write a declaration explaining why they wanted to separate and to justify the decision to others.**
