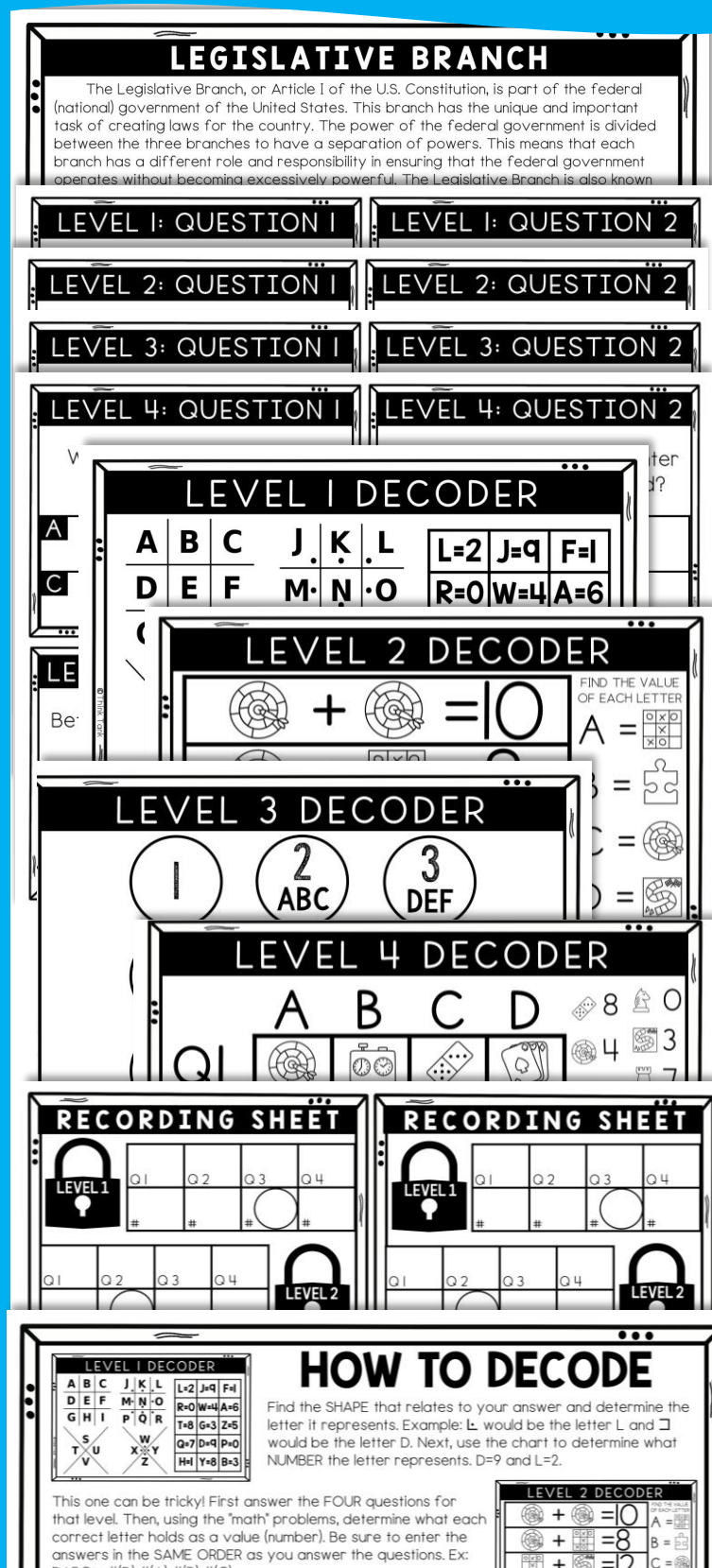

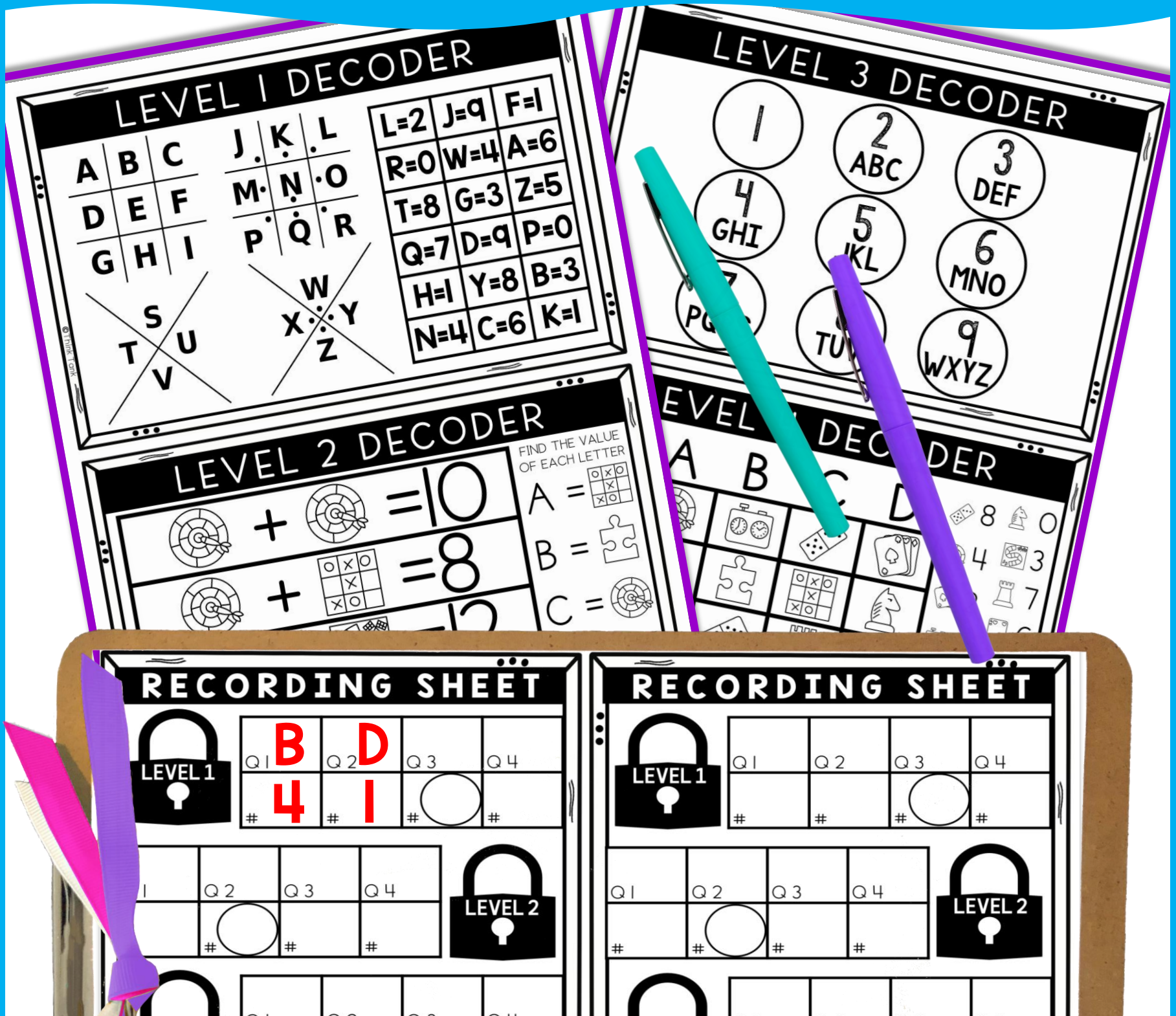

LEGISLATIVE B

The Legislative Branch, or Article I of the U.S. Constitution, is the (national) government of the United States. This branch has the task of creating laws for the country. The power of the Legislative Branch is separated between the three branches to have a separation of powers. The Legislative branch has a different role and responsibility in ensuring that the other branches operate without becoming excessively powerful. The Legislative Branch is known as Congress. Congress is bicameral which means that it is made up of the Senate and the House of Representatives.

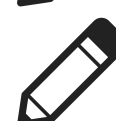
