Jamestown was established in the middle of the Paspahegh territory, a tributary of the Powhatan. The men had to find a good location to build a triangularshaped fort for safety and shelter. They chose a spot on an island that they believed would be easily defended from attacks. They named this new settlement Jamestown, after King James I.







Malaria, dysentery, and typhoid fever plagued the settlement, causing widespread illness and death. The settlers' lack of immunity to the new environment made them vulnerable to these diseases. In the winter, they had no protection against the bitter cold. By the winter of 1607, only 39 of the 100+ colonists to originally settle Jamestown were left alive.


Students work individually (or in pairs) and visit 10 reading cards scattered around the room.
