Colonists were angry at the Tea Act. A group of colonists named the Sons of Liberty were determined to let the British know they were unhappy. The Stamp Act had placed a tax on documents like newspapers and playing cards. The colonists felt that they were taxed without their approval. Patriots Samuel Adams and John Hancock led the Sons of Liberty. The group was originally known as the Loyal Nine. The Sons of Liberty was a secret organization created in 1765. They held secret meetings to discuss how to fight taxation by the British government. Their message was clear once again, "No taxation without representation."

About 900,000 pounds of cheap Dutch tea was illegally brought into the colonies every year. The Sons of Liberty encouraged people to buy the illegal tea because it was a way to boycott (stop using) British goods.

The British government knew who dumped the tea off their ships and viewed the colonists as ungrateful.

In response to the Boston Tea Party, the angry British Parliament passed the Intolerable Act, also called the Coercive Acts. These harsh laws closed the port of Boston entirely. The British Royal Navy sent warships to make sure no one went in or out of the harbor. The port of Boston would remain closed until the cost of the dumped tea was recovered. The British government also passed the Quartering Act which forced colonists to house and feed British soldiers.

The Intolerable Acts actually helped to unite the American colonists. The Boston Tea Party helped gain support in their fight for independence. The Boston Tea Party became a battle cry for independence from England.

In 1778, the British introduced the Taxation of Colonies Act to cancel the tea tax. By that time it was too late.

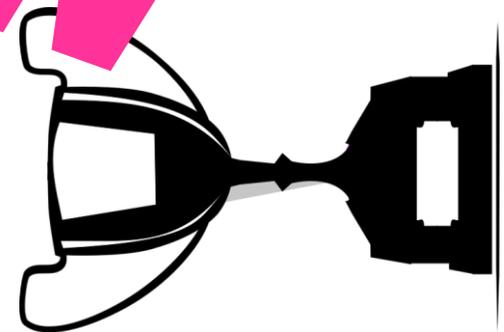
