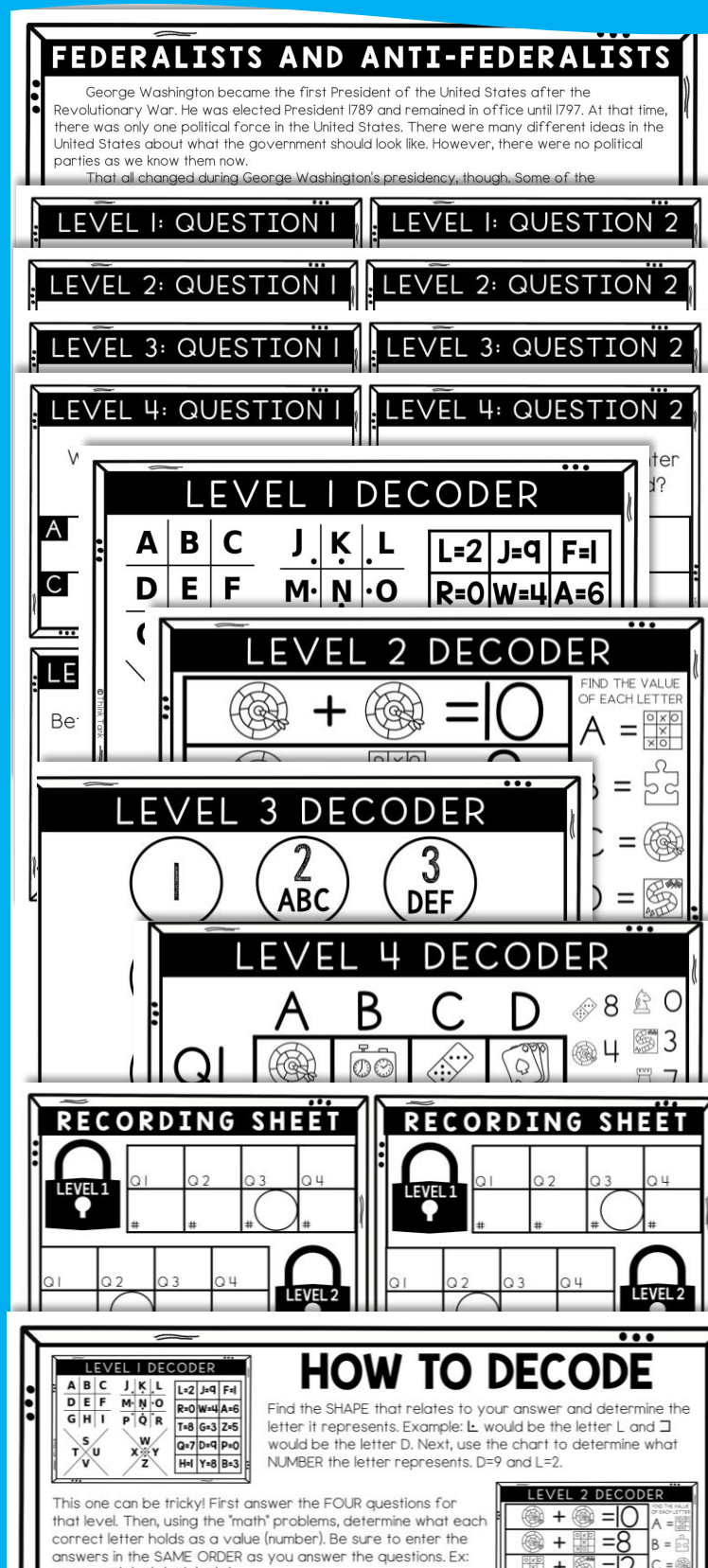

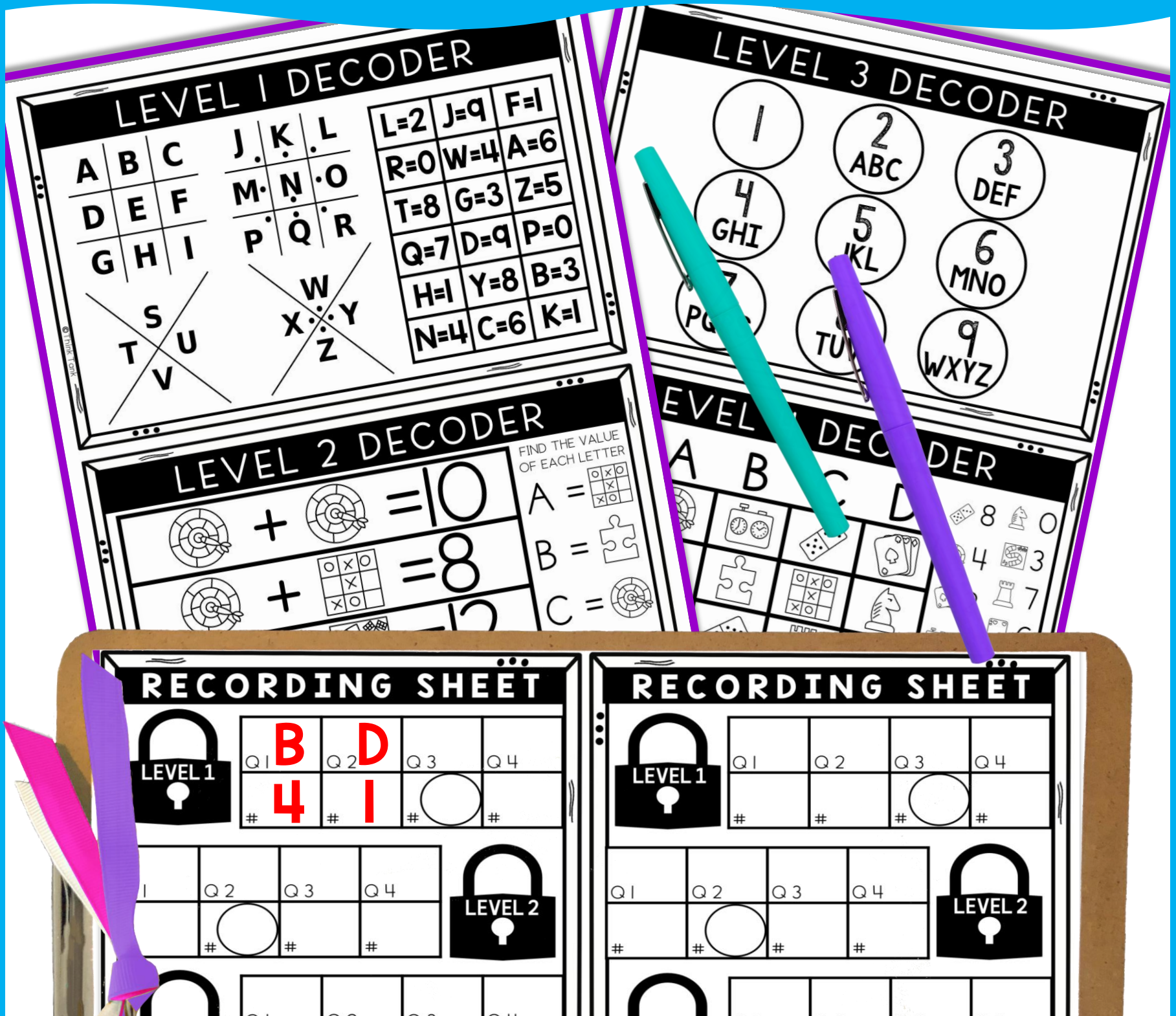

FEDERALISTS AND ANTI-FEDERALISTS

George Washington became the first President of the United States after the Revolutionary War. He was elected President 1789 and remained in office for eight years. There was only one political force in the United States. The Federalists and Anti-Federalists were the two parties as we know them now.

That all changed during George Washington's presidency. There were many different representatives of the United States who were helping to shape the new government. They had very different views as to how to run the country. They called themselves Federalists and Anti-Federalists.

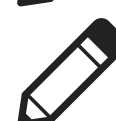
