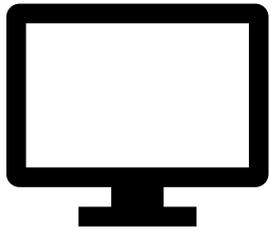

LOUISIANA PURCHASE

The Louisiana Purchase occurred in 1803. This was a purchase made by the United States from France to gain the Louisiana Territory. By acquiring the Louisiana Territory, the United States gained an additional 828,000 square miles, which doubled the size of the country.

The Louisiana Purchase was the largest purchase of land ever made by the United States. The United States had been growing quickly and was looking to expand to the west. People were looking for new land to plant crops and have more livestock for their farms.

Thomas Jefferson wanted to buy the area of New Orleans from the French. Louisiana was owned by France, and New Orleans was a large French settlement. New Orleans was also a valuable seaport for many American businesses. A port is a location where ships come in and out.

Napoleon Bonaparte received six warships and the Louisiana Territory from Spain with the Treaty of San Ildefonso. Many American leaders were against the Louisiana Purchase. Napoleon had recently taken the Louisiana Territory from Spain.

Some leaders feared that Spain may try to declare war on the United States over the land. They also believed that Jefferson did not have the power to buy such a large piece of land. The U.S. Constitution did not mention the power of the government to acquire new territory.

Jefferson argued that the Constitution allowed him to create treaties. The purchase would be a treaty of purchase. Jefferson was not sure if that was a legal argument or if it would help convince anyone opposing the purchase. Congress barely approved the decision by a vote of 59-57.


