CULTURE: Asia has a very diverse culture.

Ancient civilizations passed down their traditions to their descendants. Celebrations may include Chinese New Year, Holi Spring Festival, Diwali, Eid al-Fitr, and Hari Merdeka.

FOOD: Dim Sum is a traditional Chinese meal that consists of lots of small pieces of a bunch of different types of foods, including steamed or fried dumplings. It plays a major role in Asian culture. Ingredients commonly used in a variety of Asian cultures include ginger, garlic, sesame seeds, chilies, dried onions, soy, and tofu.

LANGUAGE: The most widely used language is Mandarin Chinese. The other two common Asian languages include English and Indonesian. Across Asia, people are speaking over 2,000 languages.
