PRESIDENTIAL FUN FACTS
... (1797) is known as the "Father of our Country." He had over 150 children and like members of his family. Washington gave the dogs unique names like Tartar and Truelove. Washington did not have a middle name. Names were not common in Europe or the colonies. He was the first president while serving as president. Adams and his rival Thomas Jefferson both died on July 4, 1826, the 50th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. Adams' last words were "Thomas Jefferson lives." Unknown to him, Jefferson had died at his estate 11 hours earlier. Although he was America's second president, Adams lived in the White House. Adams, president #3, was the only two-term president in American history. Thomas Jefferson has many accomplishments including the Louisiana Purchase and the Declaration of Independence.
