


The members of the House of Representatives are elected by the people (constituents) of the state in which they live. Every state has at least one representative, while some states have several. This is based on the population of that state. The states are divided into districts. Each representative can only represent one district.

A law in New York City might have a different impact than in rural Montana. Both the House and the Senate must agree to, vote on, and adopt identical bills in order for a bill to become a law.






Representatives at any given time. The representatives are redistributed in each state every ten years to account for the changing populations. In the very first Congress, there were only 65 representatives.

There are qualifications to become a representative listed in the Constitution. The erson must be 25 years old. They must have lived in e United States for seven years. They also must live the state that they hope to represent. If they meet these gualifications, the people can elect that person to represent them in the House of Representatives for their district. Once elected, representatives serve a 2year term. There are no term limits in the House, so a

## ENGAGING READING COMPREHENSION PRACTICE!




Students work individually (or in pairs) and visit 10 reading cards scattered around the room.
