

# Clue # 1

## Did you know?

Machu Picchu, the site of the Inca Empire, is located in the Andes Mountains in Peru.

- Francisco Pizarro González was born in Spain sometime around 1471. Francisco was born into poverty so he was raised by his parents. He spent most of his childhood herding pigs. He never learned to read or write.
- Growing up, Pizarro was ambitious and wanted to seek fortune and fame. He heard rumors of riches in the New World and wanted to find his own fortune. He sailed to the island of Hispaniola where he stayed for several years.
- In 1513, Pizarro joined Nunez de Balboa on an expedition to become one of the first Europeans to reach the Pacific Ocean. They successfully traveled the isthmus of Panama until they reached the Pacific Ocean. Pizarro was later chosen to be the Mayor of Panama from 1519 until 1523.
- Pizarro heard rumors that South America was full of gold and riches, so he made two expeditions there. He was joined by Hernando de Soto, his brothers and Diego Almagro in 1524. Pizarro and Almagro agreed to conquer and divide everything equally if they found the wealth they were seeking. The first expedition failed. Pizarro turned back without discovering anything after several of his men died.

## Did you know?

The city of Cuzco was founded by Manco Capac.

- Tension began to grow between the Spanish conquistadors and the Incas over power, wealth and credit.
- Some Spaniards were not paid any gold because they did not get along with the capture of Atahualpa.
- One group was formed to support Pizarro while another group supported Almagro, a former associate of Pizarro. Almagro and his men marched into Chile to find new riches, while Pizarro stayed in Peru.
- When Almagro returned to Peru, he was again paid. The Spaniards who stayed with Pizarro were weak because they had battled once again with Inca.
- Almagro banned Pizarro and his men for two years later, Pizarro returned with an army and fought Almagro in the Battle of Las Salinas. Pizarro captured and executed Almagro.
- Almagro had a son also named Diego who wanted to seek revenge. In 1541, Pizarro was killed and his supporters.

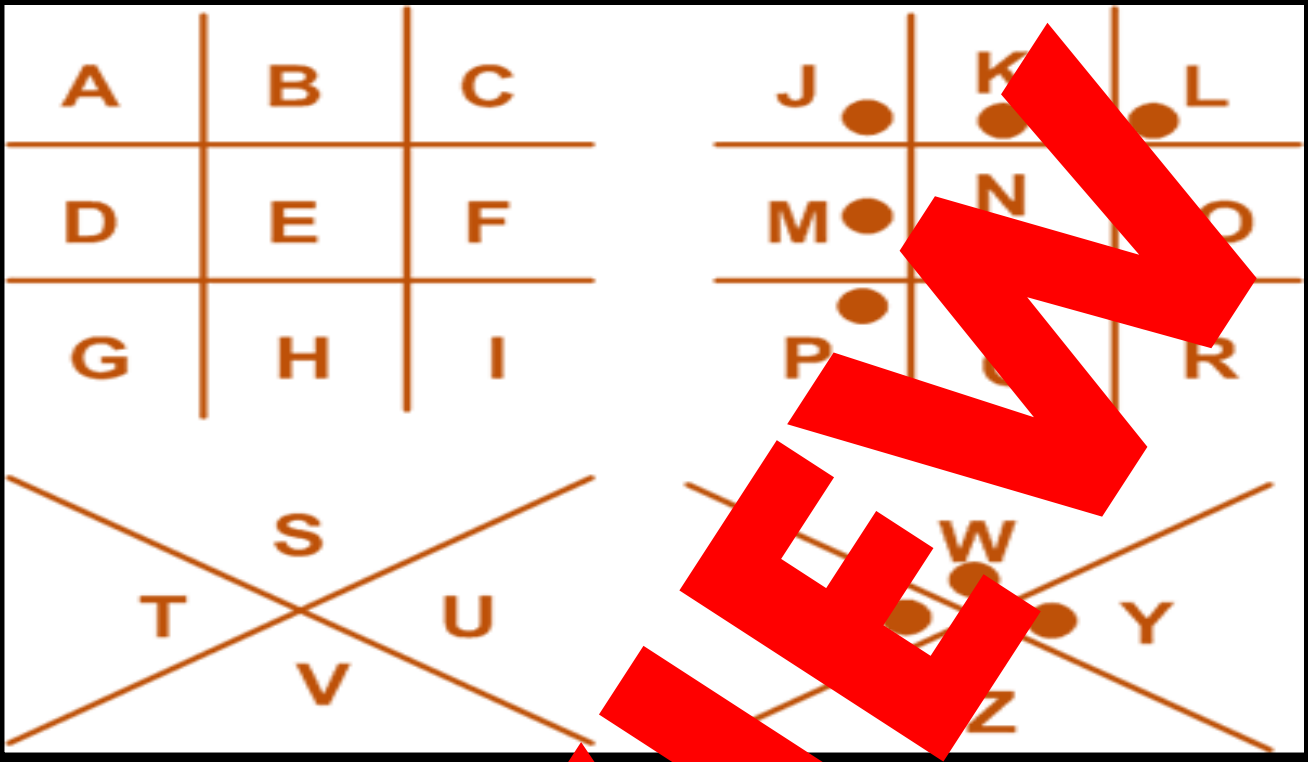

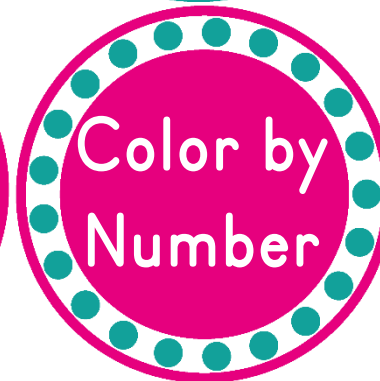
