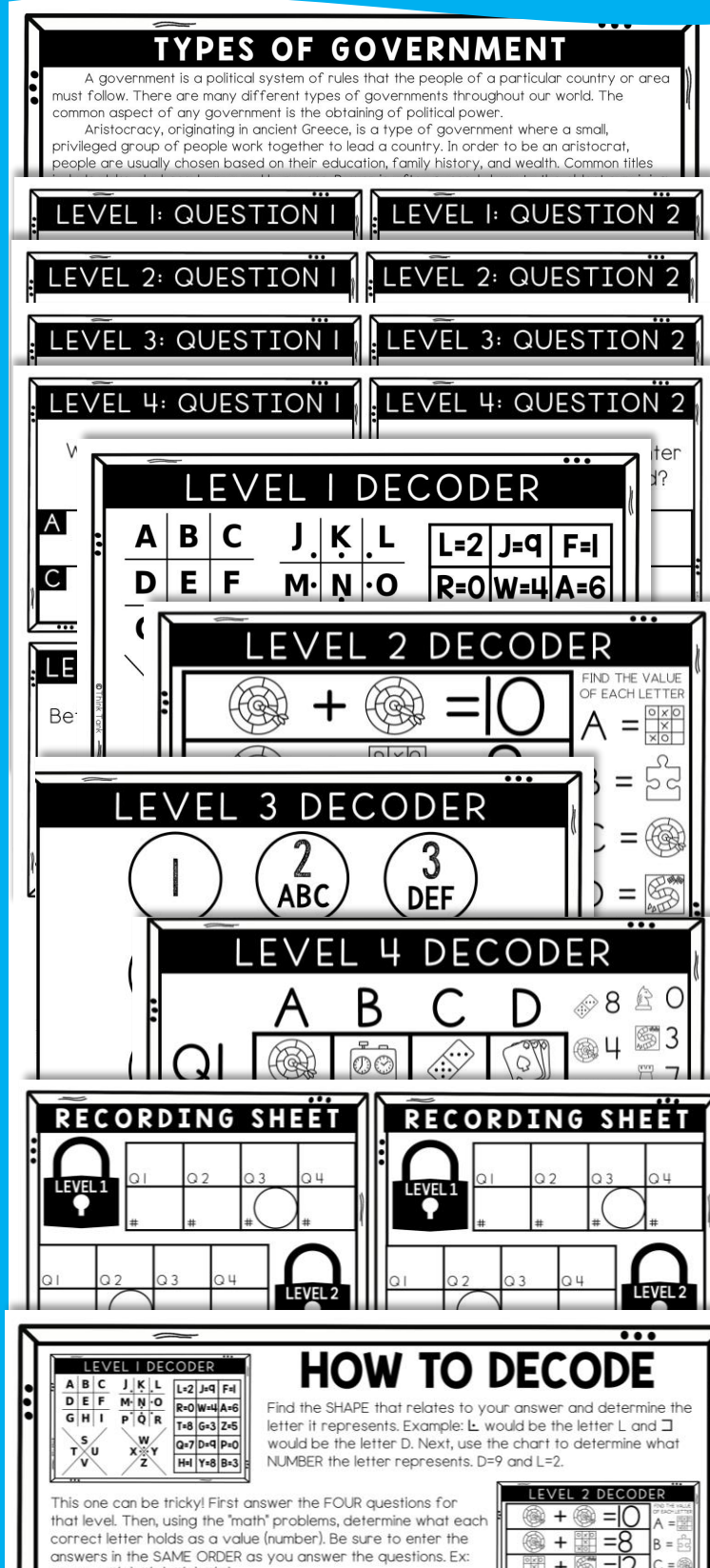

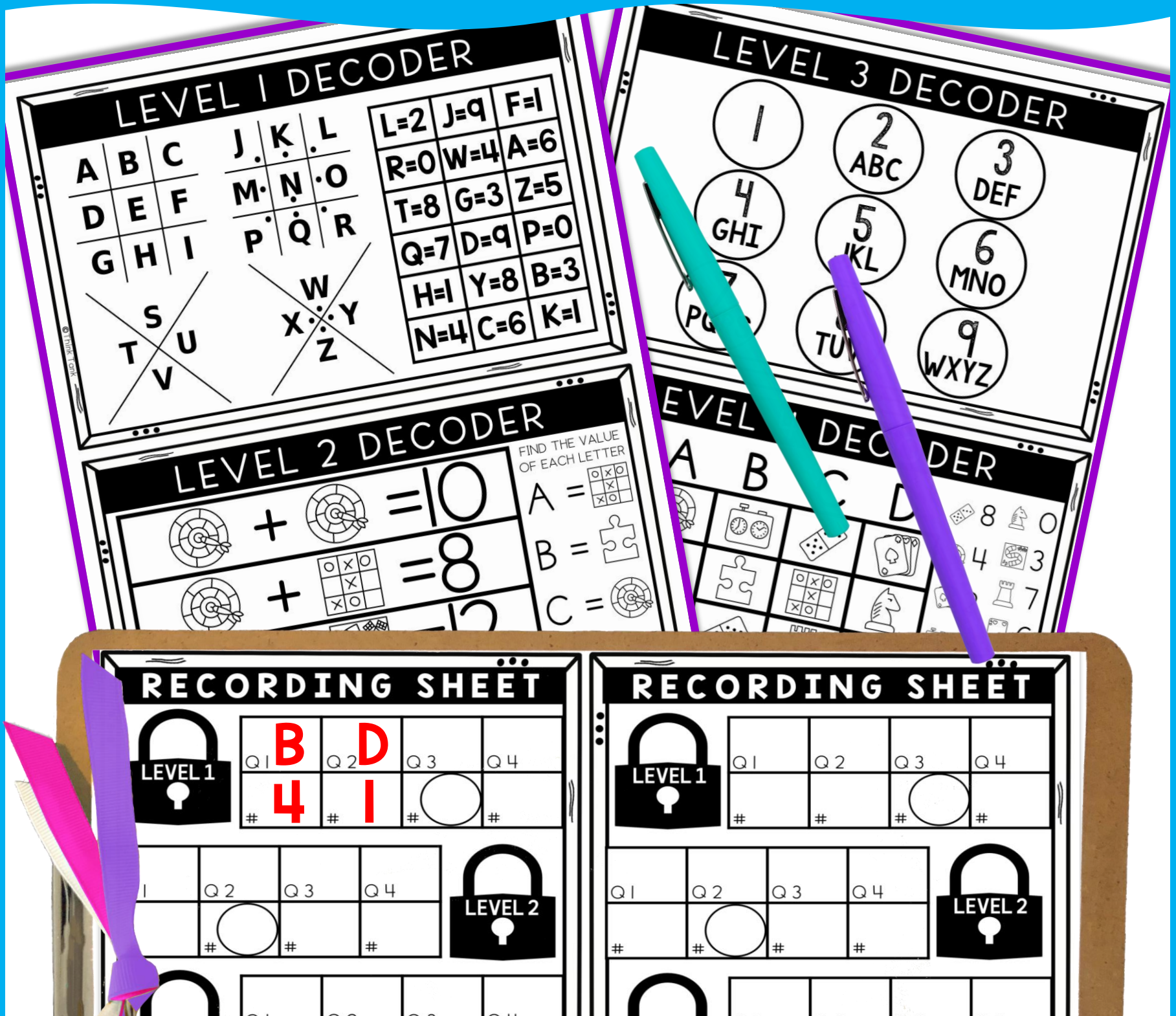

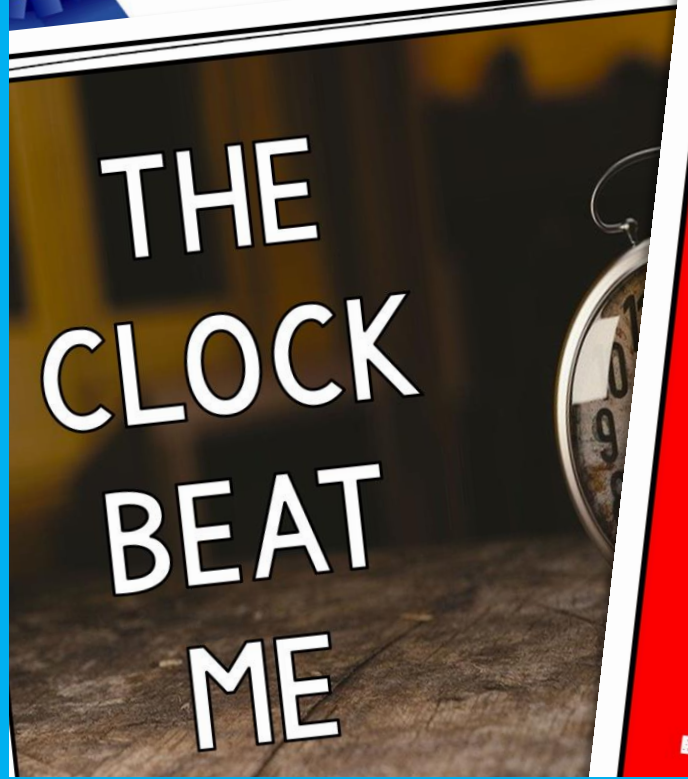

TYPES OF GOVERNMENT

A government is a political system of rules that the people must follow. There are many different types of government. One common aspect of any government is the obtaining of political power. Aristocracy, originating in ancient Greece, is a type of government in which a privileged group of people work together to lead a country. Monarchy, where people are usually chosen based on their education, family history, and wealth, include duke, duchess, baron and baroness. Power is often passed from one generation to the next. Dictatorships are defined as a form of government in which a single person holds all the power.

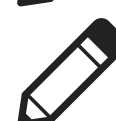
