In 1526, Pizarro's second expedition reached the borders of the Inca Empire. Eventually, Pizarro returned to Panama. He asked King Charles V of Spain for permission to explore South America again. With the king's support, Pizarro led another expedition to South America. The first Spanish settlement was established in 1532 called San Miguel de Guayaquil.

During this time, two brothers in the Inca Empire were battling for the throne. The previous emperor and father of Atahualpa and Huascar had died and both brothers wanted to rule the empire. Atahualpa won the fight, but many Inca became sick from diseases brought over by the Spanish soldiers.

In November of 1532, Pizarro met Atahualpa in the city of Cajamarca. Atahualpa was not concerned about the meeting because he had thousands of soldiers, which far outnumbered the amount of Spanish soldiers.
