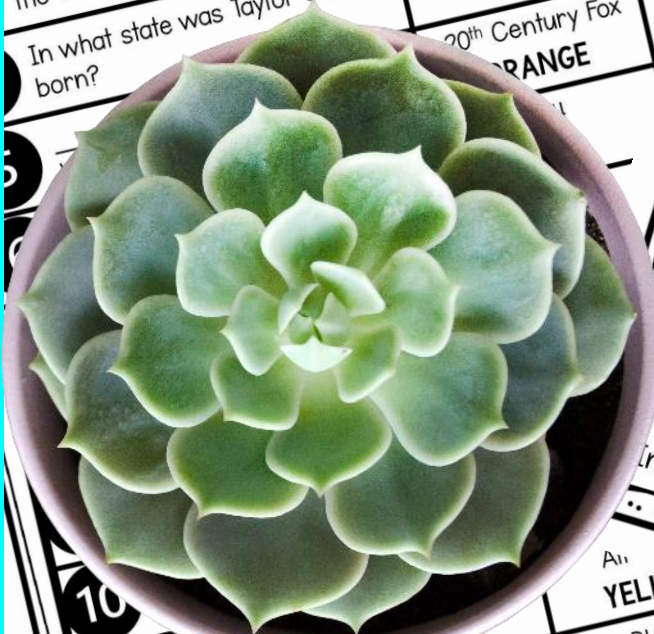

Unfortunately, due to unexpected wind gusts, their "wina-warwina" alider could not produce enough "lif" to support person. They used the setback as a learning opportunity to make their prototype more effective. Their second attempt showed improvement, but it was nearly impossible to control.

Wanting to build an engine powered plane, the brothers contacted ten different companies that manufactured gasoline motors, but none had a suitable engine. Instead of giving up, they decided to build their own engine. After weeks of failure, on December 17, 1903, they had their first successful flight. Orville piloted the plane and flew it for 12 seconds. Though it was a success, they were disappointed and hoped it lasted longer. At times, testing was stalled because they ran out of money to build planes.

During one of the test flights, a strong wind caused the 'The Flyer' plane, breaking the frame. In 1905, Orville lost control and flipped the nose-dive into the ground. Thankfully, he was not seriously injured. Instead of giving up, the brothers redesigned and built the aircraft.

The Wright Brothers sent a telegram asking the press about their flights. In response, the Dayton Journal's father to interview them.
