

<u>Ranking</u>: South America is the fourth largest continent in the fifth largest in population.

<u>Deserts</u>: The Atacama Desert in Chile is considered one of the driest places on Earth. The Patagonian Desert is Argentina's largest desert. Other deserts include the Sechura Desert, Monte Desert and La Guajira Desert.

Mountains: The highest point in South America is Cerro Aconcagua in the Andes Mountains in Argentina. Other mountain ranges include Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta, Sierras de Cordoba and Wilhelmina Mountains.

Water: Amazon River, Parana River, Orinoco River, Tocantins River, Strait of Magellan, Lake Titicaca, Lake Maracaibo. The highest waterfall in the world is Santo del Angel (also called Angel Falls). It is almost 1000 meters high! Lake Maracaibo is the biggest lake in South America. The Amazon Rainforest is the largest rainforest in the world.


