When the President nominates a candidate, the Senate Judiciary Committee researches the candidate, checks their records, looks at qualifications, and prepares for a hearing in which witnesses for and against the nominee share their

 The only constitutional requirement to become a Supreme Court Justice is "good behavior." There are no age requirements, no citizenship requirements, and no education requirements. These judges are appointed for life for a reason. They can only be removed from office by impeachment, resignation, or death. This is to ensure that the judges are focused on fairness in the trials – not focused on getting re-elected.

 Once arrested, a person will appear before a judge and is legally appointed a lawyer. If the outcome of the trial does not appear fair, it can be appealed (to ask for a review). Then, it will go to a higher court. It could potentially go all the way up to the Supreme Court. A decision that is made at the Supreme Court is final.
