READING #3

In 1775, Boone discovered a trail through the Cumberland Gap. The Cumberland Gap was a narrow passage to the Appalachian Mountains. On the other side was beautiful meadowland for farming and hunting.

Daniel and his brother stayed in Kentucky to hunt and trap furs. One day, they were both captured by Shawnee Indians. The Shawnee Indians had an agreement with England that the land west of the Appalachian Mountains was theirs. The Shawnee took Daniel's guns and horses, then sent them home and warned them never to return again.

Boone later returned to Kentucky to build roads and a settlement called Boonesborough. He and his men chopped down trees and created roads for wagons to travel on. The road was called the 'Wilderness Road'. Wilderness Road was a trail through the Appalachian Mountains from North Carolina and Tennessee through Kentucky. Boone brought his family, but the local tribes did not want settlers on their land.

Local Shawnee and Cherokee tribes did not like Boone's settlement. In 1776, they kidnapped Boone's daughter, Jemima. Jemima was eventually rescued by Daniel Boone. Within two years, Boone was also captured by the Native American tribes but managed to escape.

By the end of the 1700s around 200,000 people decided to migrate, to move, to Kentucky because of the land that Boone established.

Although he was a resourceful leader, Boone did not find success in his land. Historians believe that he did not read or write legal documents very well and often went heavily into debt to buy property. Boone lost all of his land in Kentucky by 1798. Eventually, Boone and his family moved to West Virginia, then Missouri in 1799.

Daniel Boone gained popularity when stories of his frontiersman adventures were published in 1784. These stories were based on fact and fiction.
